



Television waves are more limited than radio waves,

They travel in a straight line instead of following the curve of the earth. This means that ordinarily your reception would be limited to those stations that lie between you and the horizon.

Most people have little difficulty in tuning in local channels. How good your reception of each of these will be depends in part on your specific location with respect to the station. But even in the most unfavorable spots, you'll probably be able to get some stations.

To put it plainly, your location affects:

- The number of stations you can get with a stan-dard installation;

- 3. The auxiliary equipment you may need for best results. Whether extra equipment will be needed usually cannot be known until the set is placed in your home. By the way, surtilary equipment found necessary by the installer is subject to extra charge.

REMEMBER — Reception can vary from block to block, from house to house, from floor to floor, and even from one side of a room to another!
