Some interesting information on state in-debtedness, showing Idaho in a highly favor-able position, was released recently by the Northwest Research council of the National Association of Manufacturers at Portland.

The council's first study showed Idaho ranking 46th place in 1952—third from the lowest in the nation—in terms of state indebtedness.

The state's debt in 1962, Idahoans will be
interested to learn, was \$1,200,000, or \$2.05 per
capita on the average. This is all the more
significant when compared with the indebtedness of other Northwest states during the
same year: Washington, \$22,553,000; Oregon,
\$116,564,000; Monitana, \$44,970,000.

While the Northwest Research council
blames the rising indebtedness of states
generally on the "increasing size of our rational government," it should be particularly
significant that Idaho has kept its financial
affairs in exceptionally good shape, despite
general increase in state indebtedness.

The NRC survey showed New York state
topping the lite with a state debt of \$400,002,000. The national total of state indebtedness was \$45,471,55,000 last year.

It was interesting to learn also, as the NRC

In describing how many states have been forced to accept money from the federal government to carry on purely local activities, because of the "squeeze between rising costs and limited tax revenues," the NRO report continued as follows: "There are some 45 different programs through which the federal government sends our tax money to states in grants-in-ad Only a small part of what fathenen pay in federal taxes is ever returned to this state, however.

however.

"Our estimates indicate that in 1982, Idaho sent some \$188,000,000 in taxes to Washington, D. C., and in 1961 received only about \$12,000,000 in federal grants.

"Government hand-outs are usually accompanied by government supervision of the use of that money. Thus the states and cities loss the right to administer their affairs as they see fit.







THE MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY

THE MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY

Manufacturers of both radio and television receivers warrant that your set is without defect. In most cases, this means that if any part should prove defective under normal usage within the terms of the manufacturer's warranty, your dealer will supply you with a replacement part as promptly as circumstances will permit. Bear in mind that most manufacturers' warranties apply only when you deal with an authorized dealer. Unauthorized changes or modifications in your set, or removal or alteration of the serial number, may void the manufacturer's warranty. Warranties vary, sometimes they cover all parts, sometimes they cover only the picture tube. Sometimes they are included in the base price, sometimes you pay for them separately. Read the warranty and become acquainted with its provisions. Mind you, the manufacturer's warranty applies only to parts, not to labor, or shipping costs, or skilled services to determine the defects. Free service in the home is not included in the manufacturer's warranty.

That's where the question of scrvice comes in.-

SERVICE ON YOUR SET

Once you have selected the make and model you want, you have to decide:

- Whether to have your set installed by the retailer or another company designated by him, or whether to install it yourself (which is difficult for any one not an expert), or have it installed by someone else.
- 2) Whether to buy a service contract, which is offered by most retailers directly or indirectly, or whether to buy your set without a service contract, in which case you would pay a serviceman for any subsequent service other than the cost of replacement parts as covered by the manufacturer's warranty.

THE SERVICE CONTRACT

THE SERVICE CONTRACT

In effect, a service contract is an agreement with a service contractor who commits himself to provide maintenance and repair service. New sets are checked before they cleave the factory, and are further checked on installation. Normally you would not expect to find any defective parts in them. The manufacturer's warranty protects you in the event that you do, as far as the cost of the part goes. The service contract takes care of the cost of obtaining and installing the new part, as well as protecting you against various other difficulties that sometimes affect television receivers. This contract covers a stated period and provides that specific work will be done in certain circumstances. It is a service you contract to pay for in advance. Therefore safeguard yourself by contract with an authorized, established service dealer.






