It is not surprising that a petition is being circulated locally, protesting the proposed release of Marshall Wendell Booth, from the latte prison Dec. 30.

Booth, the "lone bandtit" who admitted 13 armed robberies in Twin Falls in 1947 before he was sent to prison, has a long criminal record, according to the petition.

It will be recalled that he opened lire upon local police officials at the time of his arrest, and that one of these officers would have had his head blown off by a shotgun blast had he not ducked just at the right instant.

Idaho is notious for its recease and parole of hardened criminals, too many of whom are freed prematurely to prey once more upon society.

It has been pointed our repeatedly that the biggest handicap in the valley wide campaign to cope with reckless drivers is the attitude of our courts. They lean over backwards time and time again to give the habitual triffe law violator a break, even though he's a potential killer on the highways.

But let someone issue a relatively small worthless check and he'll be sent off to prison with apparently no concern whatsoever.

We have had another good example of what we're talking about just this past week.
