The secretary of state need not be feared, and he can be attacked with impunity.

In a time of seemingly endless crisis and tension, many citizens and many politicians work out their frustrations on him as they never did before.

It's casy to love our-heighbor, whoever or wherever he may be. The world hasn't changed. But something momentarily has happened to a lot of people in it, and it is a pleasanter place.
