



When the British Labor party came to power in 1945, it brought a buiging kit of socialist ideas tailored to the doctrinaire pat-terns its leaders had reheared for haif a

century.

The Laborites proceeded to apply their
formula answers to many of Britain's domestic problems. They nationalized medicine and
a number of major industries.

But these stiff changes did not produce the
major results the socialists expected. And,
six years later when the Labor party was
voted out of office, the leaders setend warrily
to velcome the Inyling down of Burdens.

Carfold students of this recent British history are agreed that the Laborites' adherence
to a limited stock of doctrinate notions was
a principal cause of their downtail.

They, wanted to govern Britiahn as if it
existed in a vacuum, untouched by the powerful currents of world affaire. But British
is by definition a world nation, forced to trade
abroad to live, and to practice world diplomacy to keep the trade lanes open.

The neat, specific plants for nationalizing
