

A challenge to U. S. foreign service officers to "start pushing around" any "cookle" who calls a state department career diplomat a "cookle pusher". has just been made by Undersecretary of State Robert Murphy.

As a morale builder for the much-mallened members of the U. S. diplomatic corps, this is probably as important "s policy as has come out of the U. S. state department in years. It indicates that top career foreign service officers, bloody but unbowed from many public whippings, are at last being told to put up their dukes and tight instead of turning the other cheek for another heating, when the good name and reputation of their curps is enter attack.

Undersecretary Murphy had not been long in his new job as the third highest officer of the department when he advised foreign service officers to start defending themselves. The occasion was an unreported luncheon

service officers to start defending themselves. The occasion was an unreported lunches meeting of the Foreign Service association. Mr. Murphy spoke off the cuff. But notes were made on his remarks and this transcript checked back with him for an okay so that there can be no mishinterpretation of what he said or what he meant.

"I believe it is up to us as members of this secontation to do a little fighting in behalf of our department and foreign service," Secretary Murphy declared. "I believe that on appropriate occasion when individuals apply such language as 'cookie pusher we should start pushing that kind of cookie around." Big "Bob" Murphy oan use language of

Big 'Bob' Murphy can use language of this sort and get away with ft. Though he is nearly 60, he is six-feet-three and weights at around 235. He has been in the U. S. foreign service 23 years. He was a chief American political officer in Europe all through the war. As proof of the fact that he is no cookie pusher himself, it may be realled, that he was one of the little group which General Essenbower sent to North-Africa in a submarine, to arrange for the landing of American toops in that theater. He served as U. S. submeasactor to Beigium and Japan after the war. Secalled to Washington at the start of the Essenbower administration, Escretary Murphy found to his supprise that there was "a trend of opinion in the American community unfavorable—if not at times even antagonistic—to the foreign service.

This is the situation, with low morale reported among American foreign service officers all over the world, that apparently roused Secretary Murphy to start doing something about it.

"We are, it seems to me, better understood in many foreign countries than we are among our own people," Secretary Murphy told the foreign service luncheon group. "That condition, it I have stated it correctly, must not be permitted to continue, Most of must not be permitted to continue. Most of you have put too much sweat and too many tears into a devoted foreign service to take such a situation lying down."






