





This is an important step in an earnest effort to assuage French fears that Germany
would dominate EDC.

These fears have long constituted the central fact in the unhappy delay over ratification of the EDC pact. Recognizing this, the British have for more than a year labored in close conjunction with French and other European diplomats to produce an arrangement that could serve as an offset.

The text of the proposed treaty has not yet heen published, but there seems little question the British government is ready to commit itself. Prime Minister Churchill expressed his country's attitude toward the EDC nations: "We are with them, but not of them."

As part of the proffered plan, the British would agree to an extension of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization from the present 260-year period to 50 years—the proposed life of the EDC pact.

EDC forces and British units in Germany would serve under a common commander in furtherance of the "difficient working relationship" Britain seeks. Britain would send eitsif officers to assist in organizing European training and logistics, and to instruct in coordination of land and air warfars. There would be some interlocking of staff representation between the European army and the British army of the Rhine. Alf force linkage would be even closer.

The British feel this is as far as they can go in tying themselves into the defense of continental Europe. But they believe it ought to be far enough to prevent the Germans from dominating the West European inilitary scene, and should therefore be convincing assurance to the worried French.






