

With the "security risk" report of Philip
Young, chairman of the civil service commisson, we know a little more about the possible extent of subversion in the federal government. But still not nearly enough.

Young-told a house civil service committee
that of the new total of 2,429 security-risk
separations between May, 1953, and last Dec.
31, in the Eisenhower regime, 422 involved
persons who had something in their files of a
"subversive nature."

It is not proper to assume, however, that
all of these were fired for disloyalty. Indeed,
Young was unable to say how many were so
discharged.
The total of 422 may include, for inflatance,
men who left government service voluntarily,
with no pressure on them to get out because
of disloyalty.
In some cases, the subversive information

The real reason for firing may have been drunkenness, or some other risky habit, Sometimes, or some other risky habit, Sometimes the "flag" was on a worker's file because he had relatives behind the iron curtain, which presumably would make him a potential subject for blackmail. And, of course, Young's figures do not show how many were fired and how many resigned. So, really, all we have gained from this breakdown is a figure which might be lemend an outside limit on the number of genuine subversives in government. Within that limit, the actual total of disloyal persons could conceivably range from 10 to 350 or more. Since the topic of security firings was brought up by the Eisenhower administration with the evident intent of demonstrating its vigilance against subversion, the public is still entitled to know the exact truth about how many real subversives have been ousted Young's rough approximation is only a start in that direction.

The nation welcomes the news that the senate has at least confirmed Chief Justice Earl Warren in his high post, But the moderate-minded folk who make up the bulk of our population are unlikely to forget soon the strain upon the senate's performance in this matter.




