

MAGIC VALLEY MOVES INTO SEVENTH PLACE WITH DOUBLE VICTORIES

Stoddard, Faust Pitch Cowboys to 3-1, 7-1 Victories

IDAHOT FALLS, July 6 (AP)—The Magic Valley Cowboys moved out of the Pioneer league cellar for the first time this season Monday night when they swept a doubleheader from the Idaho Falls Bureaus 3-1 and 7-1. The double win vaulted the Cowboys over the Boise Pilots, a .7-3 victim of Pocatello.

Monday night's game was started by the Bureaus 1-0. The Bureaus' Bob Faust hit a leadoff single, then scored on a wild pitch. Art Williams until the seventh, when they rallied for two runs.

Then in the eighth, the Cowboys' Jim Stoddard, who started the rally with a double, followed "Burgess" to the plate and was walked purposefully. Carl Russells' John Wilson hooked in a pinch-hitter, but Wilson committed another free pass. Gardner then put down his bat, which went for a single.

Bob Bergman's bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the 10th drove in the winning run for Billings in the opener.

Ben Singelton opened the last game with a double, and a walk to Pablo Bernhard and a bloop single by Joe Burgess loaded the bases. With no outs, Bernhard drove in the first run, but Wilson threw the ball over the first baseman's head and the first base runner scored.

The Mustangs had tallied one run in the bottom of the eighth to tie the game after the Red Bluff Newkirk had blasted a grand-slamb home in the seventh to give him a 3-0 lead.

Billings' Jim Stoddard and Wilson gave up only four hits, but the error by Wilson was the big difference.

Free Chinese Officer Jailed On Desertion

SAN FRANCISCO, July 6.—A Chinese Nationalist marine officer, wanted in Formosa on charges of desertion, was held in a navy brig here yesterday after he was captured by U.S. immigration service officials who considered his plan to be allowed to stay in this country.

The Chinese, 30-year-old Captain Hui-Mathew, Major of the Coast Guard, had been sought a long time by the Chinese government in the City of Mexico, where he had been living since he left Formosa. He was arrested at Eureka, Calif., Saturday and flown to Oakland, Calif., Sunday. "He was to have been put aboard a ship bound for Asia," said a spokesman.

However, a navy spokesman said Captain Hui had been kept in Eureka because he was wanted for desertion. He was taken to the navy brig at Yerba Buena Island in San Francisco Bay.

Mr. Wu, former governor of Formosa who is now living in Eureka, said Hui faces certain execution if he is tried before the military commission. He has been held without trial since he was captured.

Police authorities have said Formosa has become a police state under the government of Chiang Kai-Shek.

Hui, who is serving as an asylum.

TUNISIA, July 6.—In 1952 and came to this country to train at the Quantico, Va., marine corps training center. He resigned his commission and asked the state department for political asylum.

While awaiting a decision, he worked at an Evanston hotel and took an entrance examination to Northwestern University, planning to enter school this fall.
