## French Repel Rebel Attacks On Positions

**HANOI**, Indochina, July 12.—French troops repelled 300 communist rebels who had seized the French fortress of Hung Tien during a five-hour attack, the French high command said today.

French forces, 30 miles southeast of Hanoi yesterday morning and fought furiously before the French threw them back.

The high command described the battle as "the largest battle since the French withdrew from Nam Dinh province in the southwest Riverine area."

Because of this, the high command said, not more than a few bombs can be spared to break up long supply columns of ground troops lumbering in from red China.



## Peace Sought After Clashes In Holy Land

**BERNARDAK, July 12**—United Nations peace supervisors worked to restore peace to the troubled holy land today after a week-end of border clashes between Israel and Jordan. Six Egyptians were reported killed.

The report of new violence came as the United Nations force moved to consider the wild outbreak of shooting in Jerusalem 10 days ago that resulted in the deaths of three Israelis and three Americans.

Both Israel and Jordan lodged formal complaints with the mixed armistice committee over the latest clashes. Both sides blamed the other.

An official Israeli statement reported two border clashes—in the Jordanian-controlled Golan Heights and in the Jordanian sector.

It said an Israeli unit on patrol near the village of Kessafim drew fire at sunset from Egyptian positions. The patrol returned fire and four Jordanians were killed.
