We have it on good authority that these patrolinen assembled the best of evidence it is possible to get, and we can fully appreciate the de-noralizing effect this sort of thing is having on law enforcement generally.

The point to be determined in the pub-lic's mind, it seems to us, is whether we are to be more concerned with the so-caffled "activalities of, courtroom procedure" or justice tistelf. In a good many instances there seems to be a marked distinction. The saving of human lives in any verna should take precedence over-averything class, to our way of thinking our surtey and courterom

take precedence over-wenything else, to our way of thinking.

—To-say that all our juries and courtroom procedures are ascrosanct—that they should never be criticized—is to-imply—that—theysing the procedures are faulties in every fine spect; not until they arrive at justice meyer instance without fall;—not until they procedures and deliberations will we ever authorite only and the procedures and deliberations will we ever authorite only such courts alter the specific or only such obligations. These autorneys suggest.

It's nothing new for judges and juries, the highest court in the land, even the Presi-dent of the United States himself to be


