Letter to Red Wins Release Of Young Boy

SPOKANE, Nov. 27 (AP)—A letter to the president of Poland asking that her 11-year-old son be released played a dramatic part in the reunion of the mother and the son, who for 10 years has been in hiding behind the Iron curtain.
 Mrs. Sylvia Garcia, Pullman, Wash., and Andrew Forsak met here Sunday in a pre-dawn reunion, the first time they have seen each other since 1944.
 It was in the year that Mrs. Garcia sent her young son to live with his grandmother near the Baltic sea, a long way from their home in Warsaw.
 The war years drew them further apart. Mrs. Garcia's husband was killed in the street fighting in Warsaw. Mrs. Garcia was captured by the Nazis, then by the Russians. She escaped the Reds once—only to be recaptured. It was in a Russian concentration camp that she learned her husband was dead.
 Finally she escaped to West Germany and came to the United States in 1949. She met and married Matthew T. Garcia, now a student at Washington State college.
 Mrs. Garcia made repeated efforts to Europe and the United States to have her son released from Poland, and a passport was issued for the boy's return to his mother.
 But there was no visa issued and the boy could not leave the country.
 Last Christmas Mrs. Garcia wrote a letter to the president of Poland, snoring after that, her mother got word to forward the boy's papers. Three weeks ago the visa was issued and the boy started for the United States.
 Mrs. Garcia said she has sent packages to the boy and his grandmother and received letters and pictures from them.
 So Mrs. Garcia will recognize her son. But, as mothers all, she worried. "I hope he will recognize me," she prayed. "I hope he will."

TAIPEI, Formosa, Nov. 27 (AP)—Frogmen sent out by the Chinese to spy on the Nationalists are forced to swallow delayed action poison pills as a fatal warning not to desert, the Nationalist defense ministry claimed today.
 "The ministry said the pills are fatal unless certain secret antidotes, available only if the undercover agents return to their base, are administered within 24 hours. A frogman captured on the offshore island of Matsu on Nov. 27 says the Nationalists claim the information, the ministry claimed.

WHAT DO THE PEOPLE WANT

One of the questions frequently asked these days, now that a new congress will soon be taking over in Washington, is: "What do the people want?"

It is probably reasonable to assume that the great majority of American voters was divided largely over the battle that is being waged on fundamental principles, rather than by any preference for a political party.

When the Eisenhower administration was first elected after 20 years of New Dealism in Washington, it was generally agreed that the American people wanted a change.

Generally speaking, the Republicans were elected in 1952 because they promised to clean up the mess in Washington, to bring the government back to the Korean war, and to reduce the bureaucratic payroll, cut government expenditures, reduce the government deficits and cut the high federal taxes.

To a large extent, all these promises have been fulfilled, but the Republican control of congress by a slim margin, nevertheless.

Actually there has been much improvement in this country since the present administration took over in 1952. Wage and price controls have been removed. Taxes have been cut. There is an atmosphere of honesty about the government. The nation is at peace. The national debt is much less and the deficits much smaller than they would have been if the previous administration had remained in power and continued its customary practices.

There was a lot of talk about unemployment and lower farm prices. Even though unemployment under Eisenhower has been misrepresented, the Republicans could have kept the nation at war and factory employment at a high level. They could have expanded defense expenditures. They could have launched a great public works program, "pump-priming" they could have wavered in their demand for flexible farm prices and supported 100 per cent parity instead.

But what would have been the result of such actions in connection with unemployment? The farm price program would have been much larger. There would have been more inflation and higher prices and most likely a demand for price and wage controls.

The voters, now that they have had a taste of economy and honesty in government, found it not to their liking? Are inflation and subsidized prices and "made work" now so seductive to the people that they refuse to undergo the relatively minor hardships necessary to re-establish a sound economy in America?

Ask the next man you meet what he'd like to have the federal government do for him. He'll probably say, "Reduce my taxes," and most people would agree with him.

Eisenhower May Equal Truman's Deeds In Matter of Balancing U. S. Budget

By LYLE C. WILSON Staff Correspondent WASHINGTON, Nov. 27 (AP)—President Eisenhower is barred by the Constitution from competing with the late FDR. But it is beginning to look as if he will equal the record of former President Truman in serving an entire four-year term without balancing the budget. Another deficit is on the way for the 1955 fiscal year which ends next June 30. It will be the 22d year since 1923 that the treasury has closed its books in the red. And there is no White House promise and mighty little prospect that Mr. Eisenhower will have the budget balanced in fiscal 1956, which will be the last year of his present term. Four presidents have been in office since the present almost uninterrupted series of deficits began in fiscal 1931. Herbert Hoover was president then. His memoirs assert that the Democratic majority which took office in that year played poli-

tics at the expense of the national welfare by refusing to enact revenue and other legislation which might have swung the budget back toward balance instead of further into the red. Franklin D. Roosevelt campaigned on an economy platform. His program called a 21 per cent cut in government expenditures and a balanced budget in short order. He took office in March, 1933, with economy in mind. But that plan did not last out the special session of congress which assembled here five days after his inauguration. Mr. Roosevelt made budget balancing a big project, however, and annually for some years promised to achieve it in the next.
