One of our readers took issue with our Sun ay editorial in which we saked: "What d as primite want?" what did we get the idea that unemployment under the Eisenhower administration had been misrepresented? And how did we arrive at the staggering losses the people would suffer if we had another dollar collapse similar to the inflation which took place between 1939 and 1952?

Neither should this figure be isolated from the fact that the economy over the past year has been in the midst of a crucial adjustment from the war-inflated peak of a superson of the control o suring those recent times, there were workers who, for one reason or other, failed to find obs. Yet many of those demanding—"full unployment," are actually demanding "full unployment," which means as a practical amployment," which means as a practical natter, perpetual inflation. Thus, paradical-vally, the more extreme outery against any employment at all becomes not a demand or a healthy economy, but for policies that rould put the basic soundness of the economy iself in Jeopardy, and lead on ultimately to ollapse.

This is small solace, of course, to those presently out of work through no wish or fault of their own. But not all the three million are in that category. That figure does not represent a solid, stagmant mass that is identified with economic depression. In part, at least, it represents the normal play that lakes place in a free economy, where various firms compete within industries. It is representative, also of an economic system based on
