Two many Asians still seeze something "im-perialistic" in almost every move the United States makes in Asia. However unreasonable this may be, we still must find means of com-batter.

A third vital consideration which makes the A third vital consideration which makes the coperative aspect of the proposal attractive is that the American congress is unlikely to approve a sweeping ald plan for Asia under which the U.S. alone would bear the burden. We have already borne the aid load too long in too many places.

The proposal would resemble the Marshall plan more closely in one major respect: The Asiatic countries would be asked form an organization of their own, like the one in Europe, to formulate a program of needs and requests.

Dr. Enrice Fermi, who died the other day at a premature 53, was one of the more remarkable of the collaborators. His part in the vital work that led to a nuclear explosion was, of course, tremendous. It was atleast recently by Chairman Lewis Strauss of the adomic energy commission, which carrier that awarded Fermi a special 325,000 grant for his contribution.
