Dulles Flies to Paris to Help German Issue

WASHINGTON, Dec. 13 (AP)—Secretary of State John Foster Dulles will fly to Paris tomorrow to try to bolster French support for German reunification in the face of a crescendo of threats from Moscow.

Dulles is said to be worried about the effect recent Soviet propaganda may have on the showdown vote coming up in the French assembly on ratification of the allied plan for freeing and rearming West Germany.

There is a feeling here that the Russians are actually resigned to German reunification. But officials believe the plan is a trap to lure the French into the French position, and are anxious to prevent the French from slipping the scales in favor of the rejection.

Dulles will confer with French Premier Pierre Mendes-France and British Foreign Secretary Anthony Eden in advance of the North Atlantic council meeting opening in Paris Friday.

The council is expected to approve a broad defense program putting more emphasis on airpower, improved training of ground troops, better equipment and more ammunition, and the strengthening of reserve forces.

Tentative plans call for the construction of many new airfields in Europe during the next two years and a report of NATO military leaders urging the maximum possible use of atomic weapons in Europe's defense system.

Idaho Irrigated Land Increases

OMAHA, Dec. 13—Irrigated land in Idaho has been increased by 22,110 acres since 1945, it was announced today by J. W. Jarvis, supervisor of Union Pacific railroad's agricultural development department.

Jarvis said that of the total, 181,300 acres were brought under irrigation by private capital, the remainder by the U. S. bureau of reclamation.

It is estimated, Jarvis added, that in the next 10 years that an additional 45,000 acres will be irrigated in Idaho and adjoining Montana and Utah.

Outlook Dark for Commercial Trout Growers, Survey Shows

A survey of the Rocky Mountain Troutmen association, representing 20 commercial trout growers in Idaho and Utah, discloses their combined commercial rainbow trout output for 1954 was 2,125,000 pounds, costing 55 to 60 cents per pound to produce, but that 1954 business was off and the 1955 business outlook is poor, reports Robert A. Erkins, Buhl, secretary.

Erkins said the production cost is based on the five weight of the trout and includes all costs and federal, state and local taxes.

Of the total production, 225,000 pounds of market size rainbow trout were sold for livestocking tanks, streams and ponds for sport fishing. Some 1,675,000 pounds were dressed, processed and either sold or are now in frozen storage and an estimated 225,000 pounds remain in hatchery rearing ponds from the past year's crop, Erkins said.

The survey also revealed that feed costs ran from 15 to 25 cents to raise one pound of trout.

Erkins attributed the slow 1954 trout market and the gloomy 1955 forecast to the highly productive 1954 growing year when domestic growers had smaller losses and brought in their largest trout crop to date.

"This trout surplus, added to severe foreign competition, cuts the trout market," Erkins said, "since trout is selling at half the price required to keep domestic growers in business." Foreign trout still are being "mislabeled" in some western areas as rocky mountain rainbow trout, he reported.

Group Forms To Investigate Common Cold

NEW YORK, Dec. 12 (U. S. P. M.)—The common cold costs business in this country about 150 million work days a year, it must be money, so a group of industrialists are forming the Common Cold Foundation and backing new try for a cure, preventative, or both.

The sneeze, cough and sniffle season, however, has other victims in the business world than the loss of man hours or the drop in efficiency. If the conscientious worker does show up on the job.

For one thing, there's a growing market for the various treatments and devices that individual Americans now swear by when they seek relief from the onslaught of the common cold.

Which—like the United States—public health service estimates will tally 500 million colds in this country in the next 12 months.

The common cold, moreover, is a prime ailment in the season now under way, for the makers of such things as atom doors and windows, or the latest in furnaces, and for the producers of fuel. It is also a star ailment for whisky—although some contend a cold is more of an excuse than a selling point.

The first of the season's epidemic of sniffles also zones the sale of mufflers, overcoats, rubbers and electric blankets.

Once one of those 600 million colds latches on to you, the makers of pills and nose drops and inhalators take over.

There are, for instance, 7½ million vapors in use in the United States, according to officials of Kax Manufacturing company, New York. The company is one of a number making electric vaporizers—an outgrowth of the old crowd of "hot" which grinds heated over an open flame alcohol lamp.

Vaporizer industry sales jumped 22 per cent in 1938, and the Kax concern estimates its sales will rise this year by 45 per cent.

But against the day the common cold might be completely licked, Vick Chemical company, which once was entirely devoted to various treatments, has branched out into such other lines as chemicals, plastic, perfumes, cosmetics and toiletries.

Today, however, thousands of workers will have their wives call the boss and say: "Harry has a cold and won't be in."

Red Countries Discourage All Yule Activities

VIENNA, Dec. 11 (U. S. P. M.)—Christmas will not amount to much for 10 million in communist east Europe this year.

Communism supposedly has let up a little in its persecution of the church and there are supposed to be more luxury goods available in the state-run stores. But all indications from the communist press are that Russia's communist satellites are going ahead with long-range plans to eliminate Christmas entirely.

In the schools of Poland, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Rumania and Bulgaria, the children are being taught their parents are wrong. The next day of school will be the day of the birth of the communist state.

Public celebrations of Christmas are being discouraged.

There will be fir trees in the streets of Warsaw, Prague and Budapest but they will be known as "new year's trees," or "winter trees."

There will be parties for the kids in schools and in the halls of communist organizations. But they will be held around Jan. 1. In them, the children will see films about the Soviet Union and puppet shows in which the "bogymen."

There will be special holiday radio programs for children but mostly devoted to the communist concepts of "peace and friendship."


