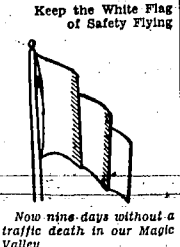

U. S. Supreme Court Begins New Schedule

WASHINGTON, Jan. 31 (AP)—The supreme court, with a backlog of more than 80 cases, resumes a full work schedule today following a recess of several weeks.

Boxing Case Stalled... The only major case which could be decided today involves the status of boxing under anti-trust laws.

Former Minister Asks for Change

LOHNOV, Jan. 31 (AP)—Romanian Prime Minister Clement Attlee said today in the Labor party newspaper Daily Herald that Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek should be sent into exile as one of the first steps in ending the peril of war over Formosa.

It also suggested that the United States leave Formosa out of its island defense ring since the hydrogen bomb has made it unnecessary.

He also suggested that Formosa be neutralized until its inhabitants decide by plebiscite whether they want to join Communist China.

Reply briefs will be submitted Friday and Idaho Power will file its rebuttal arguments Feb. 21. Hearing Examiner William J. Costello is expected to write his decision in April or May, after the decision has been appealed to the FPC which, may finally decide the case in the fall.

Decision of the FPC, of course, could be appealed to the courts.
