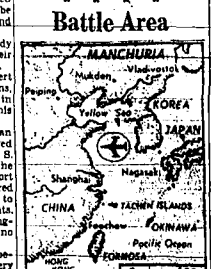

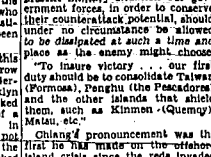

Plane symbol indicates Yellow sea area west of Korea where U. S. air force Sabrejet shot down a Communist bomber Saturday morning.



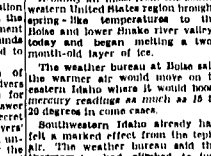

New Drug Use in Lamb Feed
Puts on More Pounds Faster

BUTLE, Feb. 7 — The sheep feeder who can get his lambs to market at full weight—healthier and blockier—at four months stands to realize a substantially higher profit than the one who requires five months.

Some 25 lamb growers in Magic Valley area are getting exceptional results from pelletized creep rations to which Aureomycin—chemical name, chlorotetracycline—has been added.

They report their lambs are ready for shipment much earlier than animals fed the ordinary mixed grain diet—in some cases 30 to 45 days earlier.

Increases in growth have been so amazing, Melvin J. Jagels, Buhl rancher, claims, he has been accused at times of letting his lambs graze on wild alfalfa.

Another lamb gained 195 pounds, from 77 to 97 pounds, on the same ration over the 31-day test period. That's an average daily gain of more than 1.75 pounds.

Jagels runs a large range type lambing operation on 130 acres in Clover, southeast of Buhl. One of Jagels' neighbors, Melvin P. Oppinger, runs about 240 ewes and on his 230-acre farm two miles east and three miles south of Buhl and also uses the Aureomycin supplement. He turns his lambs to the self-feeder in the creep pen about two weeks after birth. Both men favor the pelletizer feed because misreading sparrows shun it, Oppinger reports.

It costs Oppinger about one cent a day extra per lamb to include Aureomycin-in the rations. But this more than offsets the weight gain, feed efficiency, and shortening of the time to market. Oppinger estimates that Aureomycin saved \$500 to \$800 in feeding costs last year.

Water Tower for Shoshone Is Placed in Use After Repairs

SHOSHONE, Feb. 7 — The city water tank was put to use Saturday after approximately two months vacation for repairs. Mayor Joe Pasogase reported Monday.

The tank was filled and disinfected on Friday night and the disinfected water was pumped into the river Saturday. The tank then was filled for testing.

The test was satisfactory and water lines were filled from the tank for the first time in several weeks. Water for the city mains was pumped directly from the well through an automatic valve while repairs were being made.

All that remains on the repair job is painting the exterior, the mayor said. This will be done as soon as weather permits, he added.

Work on the tank was done by the Gots Tank Company, Oakland, Calif. Three Shoshone men, Arthur Rosacker, O. T. Knight and George Hall, have made periodic inspections of the work and report a "thorough" job has been done, the mayor said.

Work done on the lower five years ago was faulty and threat of another collapse prompted the city council to declare a state of emergency and order the work done. The water tank fell down about 10 years ago.

Russ Disputes Turn Circle to Stalin's Ideas

LONDON, Feb. 7 (AP)—The ideological dispute that has raged in the top echelon of the Communist party of Russia since the death of Premier Joseph Stalin has led to a fight back to where Stalin left off.

Soviet experts here detect a clear assumption of shift toward "new" policies in every field of Russian endeavor. This is their conclusion based on an analysis of the latest speech by party secretary Nikita S. Khrushchev and the new budget presented to the supreme Soviet last week.

No Friendship Seen The experts also doubted whether any conciliatory gesture could be expected from the Kremlin on foreign policy.

The shift was pointed up by the renewed emphasis on heavy industry which was proclaimed both by Khrushchev in a speech to the central committee and finance minister Alexey Gerasimov in a speech of a significant increase in Soviet defense spending.

1953 Line Is Dead The "new general party line is seen here as meaning the "new course" emphasizing consumer goods production, begun in 1952, is now officially dead and buried.

A combination of reasons is seen for the change. But the main ones are believed to be the necessity of producing more tractors for the gigantic land reclamation program in Kazakhstan and the military and industrial commitments to Red China.

According to official British sources the size of the Soviet military establishment has not increased during the last 12 months. It is believed to be the result of money for defense will be used mainly to step up Soviet research and development work.

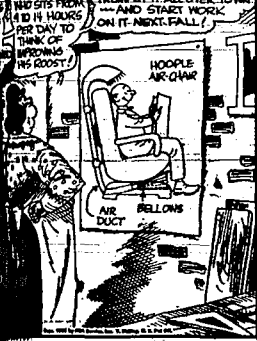

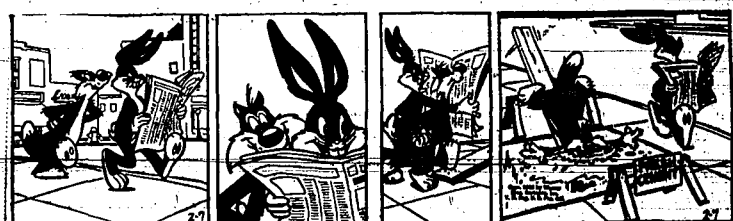
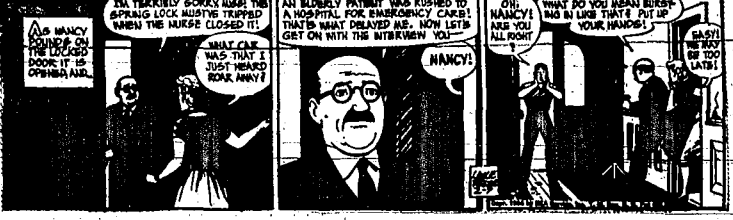
