The victim, to be sure, is only a LOCAL MERCHANT, but the beneficiary is an interstate business; the treasury used to finance the warfare is drawn from interstate, as well as local, sources which include not only respondent but also a group of interlocked companies engaged in the same line of business and the prices on the interstate sales are kept high while the local prices are lowered. IF THIS METHIOD OF COMPETITION were approved, the pattern for growth of monopolywould be simple... interstate business could expand with imwould be simple interstate business could expand with impunity at the expense of LOCAL MERCHAN'IS.
