Basically, good public behavior stems both from selfrespect and respect for your fellow men. If you think well of them, then it will be natural for you to act as if you knew they were around and had rights of their own, rights which often conflict with yours. Then you will exhibit kindness and deference and courtesy. This is what we mean by "accommodation." There must be much more of it. If life in America's public places is to be

not only bearable but pleasant, attractive and rewarding in the crowded years ahead.






