War on Milk Ends; Liquid Is Old Price

SALT LAKE CITY, April 8 (AP)—Utah's milk prices were ended almost as abruptly as it began last night after a plea by Gov. J. Bracken Lee for "restitution rather than force."

Milk, which dropped to 10 and 12 cents a quart yesterday—even as low as five cents at one outlet—will return to its normal 21 cents today. That is the price at which it sold before the war broke out in earnest Monday.

One retailer in Salt Lake City, Emmett D. Ripney, was selling milk at five cents and said he got rid of "several thousand" quarts that way. "We are losing eight cents a quart at that price," Ripney said, "but we had decided to bring this thing to a head and to have a little fun in the process."

Lee stepped in with a plea for negotiation after an 11-hour meeting of milk retailers and producers yesterday. The meeting broke up without reaching any settlement, appealing to Lee to give it a try.

Lee said last night that he had received assurances that a major grocery chain—long retailer who had been unwilling to raise its normal prices—would go along with the price.

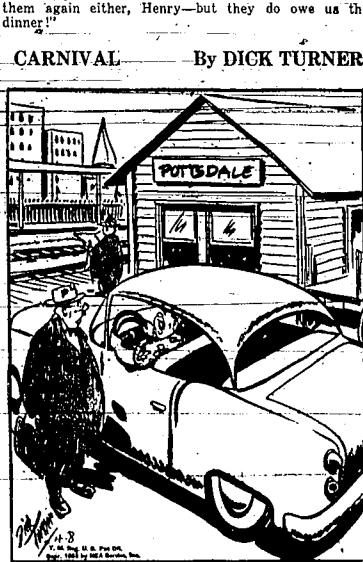

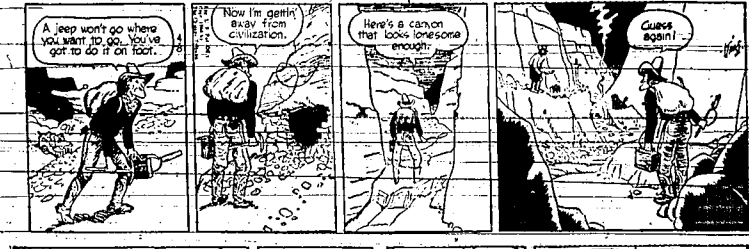

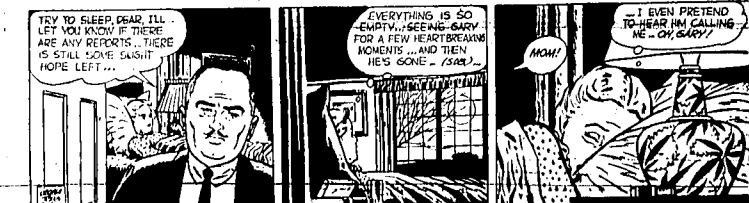

Chamber Unit Has Plans for Another Dam

BURLEY, April 8 — Directors of Burley Chamber of Commerce approved a resolution Wednesday asking Idaho congressmen to investigate the possibility of a regulatory dam immediately below Palisades dam.

Several chamber members expressed opinions that development must be promoted immediately. The consensus of opinion is that in the event of a federal high dam in Hells canyon, the federal government would be reluctant to contribute towards or even permit the construction of another upper dam.

Mayor J. L. Salmon said a definite power shortage exists in the area, and that even with Palisades in full power production, he foresees the beginning of another power shortage by 1960. He said the city would find it too complicated if it continued to get its power from public power sources.

Edgar Moorman said another dam below Palisades would help alleviate power shortage. He said there is another 45,000-acre-foot of water for irrigation purposes. He said that in his opinion, people with obtaining power through private sources is public property, and that the financing of another dam below Palisades would need generous government support.

Don Clinton, who attended the Hells canyon dam hearing in Boise, said his impression of the hearing was that the entire state was a "political fix." He said the Hells canyon issue has degenerated into a fight between public and private power factions as to who will dominate power development, and that the interests of the people most vitally concerned have been submerged. He praised Gov. Stanley E. Burdick's efforts at the hearing. The directors approved the attendance of their executive secretary, Roy L. Titus, at the meeting of the Idaho Association of Commercial and Trade Executives at Boise April 17 and 18.
