REFUGEE LAW NOT WORKING

REFUGEE LAW NOT WORKING
It seems proper to have a look at the nation's 1953 refugee relief act in an atmosphere fairly free of the recent scientised Gorsi controversy. Its operations should be judged apart from the hot Issue of personalities.

The law provides that, over and above regular immigration quotas, some 209,000 new refugees, escapees, and other displaced individuals who were vietims of nazi or communist oppression may be admitted to the United States.

The refugee program is to span a three-year period ending Dec. 31, 1956. Virtually half that time has now gone by Up to April 8 of this year, only 1,681 new refugees and escapees had gained admission to this country, in addition, 582 orphans entered, as did 15,201 relatives of American citizens. Relatives are admissible anyway, under regular immigration quotas.

At the present rate of admissions, some 2,100 refugees and escapees will have been admitted. This would represent almost exactly one per cent of the permissible total of 200,000.

On its face, this is a dismal showing. It is

209,000. On its face, this is a dismal showing. It is so bad, in fact, that it makes plain that something is radically wrong. Barring an unlikely heavy rush of admissions in the remaining year and a half, the general purpose of the refugee act will not be realized. The natural question is: Why not?

ASSESSED VALUATIONS in Twin Falls County are NOT based on INFLATED PRICES, but rather on the 1937-41 period. All of you as taxpayers have a COPY of your 1955 Assessed Valuations. If you sincerely feel that you have a JUST and REASONABLE complaint to make regarding these ASSESSED VALUATIONS, you should in all fairness make that complaint to the assessor's office NOW and NOT when you get your TAX NOTICE which will be mailed to you in November

We in the assessor's office are not infallible to making mistakes, and we shall be glad to correct any that might be mode on our part.

Again, let me emphasize to you as Taxpayers, your county assessor DOES NOT LEVY TAXES, if you have a complaint regarding ASESSED VALUATIONS make it now and not when you get your tax notice this Fall.
