



Tax weary Americans who do a lot of bellyaching about waste and inefficiency in government, but wouldn't go to-the-trouble oftaking a teaspoonful of sodium bloarbonate to
settle their stomachs, no doubt read with
passing interest the report which Herbert
Hoover made in an address to the 38th annual meeting of the national industrial conference board Thursday night.

Mr. Hoover was reporting on the findings
of the second commission which he has headed on recommendations for reorganization of
our tax head to say was significant enough
and offered a rather simple solution to a lorof our tax headaches, but as he implied in his
opening remarks, the selfishness of pressure
groups and the procecupation of politicians
with their ears to the ground stand in the
way of any such simple effectiveness.

For instance, Mr. Hoover presertiled—one

way of any such simple effectiveness.

For instance, Mr. Hoover prescribed one little "pill" which might work wonders if taken willingly by the average citizen, the pressure groups, and all others concerned.

"Our job is to find ways of saving money," he said, "I may tell you that in the reports which we will have completed in the next few days, our separate task forces estimate that an aggregate of 6 billion dollars of savings could be made to the taxpayer. And beyond that there could be returned to the treasury about 7 billion dollars of money which could be provided otherwise. And there are still more to come."

Mr. Hoover expressed the hope that the pressure of American common sense will secure 70 per cent of "our present recommendations in the next five years." But before xx pressing that hope he submitted passages from the "revised edition of Acsop's Fables" in which he pointed out how anti-waste pills preactibed by the family doctor only met with protest from his patients because they feared such a prescription would destroy their mortals and the pointed out how any one of the 1,000 pressure groups represented in Washington would always see how the other 909 are badly in need of reform.

"Some of the ways of managing were good enough before the government multiplied its size 14 times in 25 years," said Mr. Hoover. "Bome of these faulty systems are due to obsolete legislation . . . the ancrosante character of bureaucratic empires . . pressure groups that profit from the present stup . . . and the primary emotion of resentment being waked up."

These qualities are not stimulated by their form of accounting and the open doors of the United States freamary."
