

Our INDEPÉNDENCE

No nation is prouder of its independence than the United States. Yet even we have had to learn that independence has changing meanings.

When the founding fathers signed the like the Decisration on July 4, 1776, they had in mind the kind of freedom that spells true separate ress. They wanted a budding America free to make all its own decisions, without any interference from outside.

It's fair to say that is the kind of country clear it

interference from outside.

It's fair to say that is the kind of country they created. We needed foreign economic help to get going, but once we were on our feet we stood as a great continental empire, as nearly self-contained as any nation ever

and been.

Absorbed in our own concerns, we lived and rew and prospered. We wanted no part in rorld political affairs, and took none.

Today, for us and most others on this lanet, there can be no such independence, we would protest a reasonable freedom tohele for ourselves, we must live and work spart of a team of friendly nations.

as part of a team of friendly nations.

Not even the most powerful country on earth can hope to exist as a lone wolf. Indeed, as a powerful land we are in particular need of friends, for we are the obvious target of any potential enemy. We are the nation which above all must be destroyed if any powerful rival is to command the globe.

So pressing is our need for the group strength that comes from interlocking the forces of many lands that we have gone to the extreme of asking our enemies of World war II, Japan and Germany, to rearm on our side.

side.

The legal and material ties that have been fashioned in pursuit of this group strength are in many cases unique to American life and history. Never before, for instance, have we taken part in a military alliance like

and history. Never before, for instance, have we taken part in a military alliance like NATO in peacetime.

But we must not feel that these ties make a web-which-vitaily—constricts—our freedom and independence.

It is quite true that a member of a team cannot make individual decisions with the cavaller abandon that a lone wolf does. We must accommodate many of our actions to the needs and wishes of the whole team. But the more impressive fact is that in today's world a lone wolf stands a very good chance of being a dead wolf. And that kind of freedom is not something many men would go searching for.

Being a part of a friendly group is now the only way a nation like ours can hope to preserve any important measure of liberty. We yield the power to make many choices alone, but we still hold the right to make countiess decisions that affect our lives deeply. This may not be quite the perfect independence the signers of the Declaration envision. But we still rever it is an independence they would be happy to enjoy and to have had a part in creating.






