Registering of Autos Is High In State Area

DUBOIS, July 6 (AP)—Idaho's Clark county, with a population of 225, may have the highest per capita registration of motor vehicles in the United States. Substantiating the claim, A. J. Leonardson, county assessor, says: "Sixty passenger cars and 188 trucks bear license plates from the county—one car or truck for every 1.27 residents."

Plates from Alaska, Leonardson says, many of the licenses have been issued to persons who do not live in Clark county, never have and never will. Many probably do not even know where the county is. The bulk of the out-of-state sales are made, Leonardson says, by salesmen who have heard of Idaho's \$5 licensing fee. As a result of such sales, the "5-C" prefix which identifies Clark county car license plates can be seen in 14 states—Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Florida, Georgia, California, Montana, New York, Washington, Nevada and Tennessee—as well as in the Territories of Hawaii and Alaska, and several European countries.

The county assessor says most states do not require servicers to obtain local licenses until after a fairly lengthy tour of duty in the states. 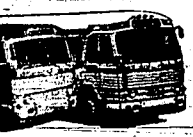

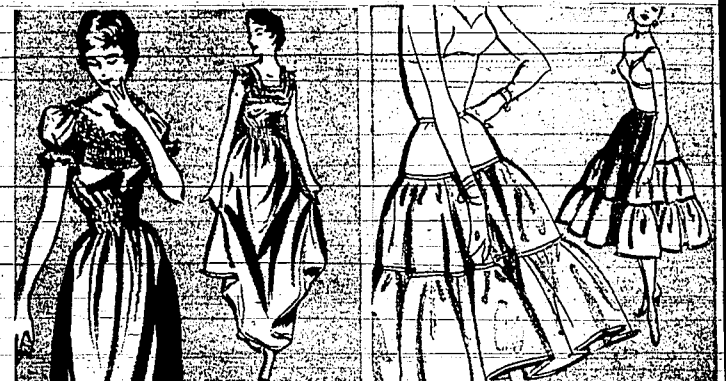

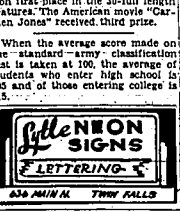
