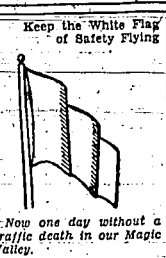

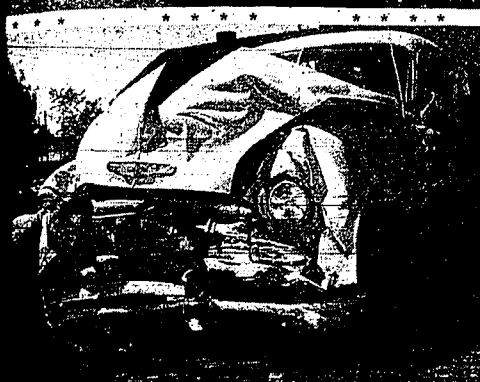

Nehru Favors Red Campaign On Friendship

ROME, July 8.—Indian Premier Jawaharlal Nehru today scored at the idea that Russia's current "friendship" campaign was due to weakness.

"Anybody who believes the Soviet's present policy was prompted by weakness is suffering under a completely erroneous impression," Nehru told a press conference.

The Indian premier made the statement in reply to questions concerning his current "co-existence" tour of Asian and European countries. Among the countries he visited were Russia, Poland and Yugoslavia.

Nehru met newsmen at his hotel after being received in a private audience by "Four Plus Two" officials. The audience concluded the premier's whirlwind visit to Italy, a country successively open to his "co-existence" policies.

It was Nehru's first meeting with the pope, although he has passed through Rome several times since World War II.

Following the press conference, Nehru was to leave for London for pre-Geneva talks with British leaders.

Nehru made these principal points: "Anyone who thinks that the present Russian policy is the least weak is suffering under a completely erroneous impression."

"I came away from Moscow with the impression that there is more chance for peace and peaceful settlement than existed before."

"Under existing circumstances, co-existence is an inevitable necessity."

"People who believe they can exist without co-existence," Nehru said, "are not living on this earth but on the moon."

The system was installed by Terry and two men from the Water Works Equipment Company, from which the equipment was purchased. Overall cost was approximately \$2,300, Terry said.

A representative of the state health department in Boise will be in Shoshone Monday to check on the proper amount of fluorine and daily checks will be made by city employees.

The installation of fluorine came as result of several months planning. A series of educational programs on the subject were held last winter by Dr. E. D. Barna, Shoshone. A clinic of financial assistance to the city were made by a number of community organizations.

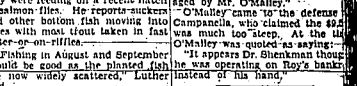

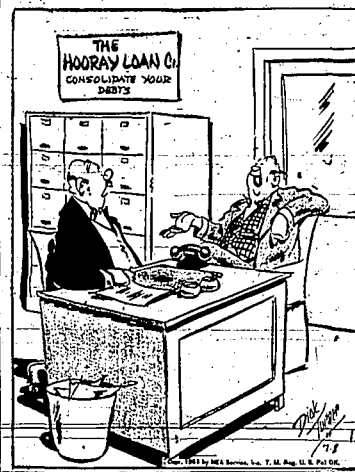

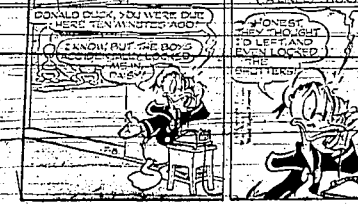
