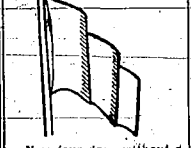

POWER HUNGRY PERON

Argentine President Juan Peron's blows against the Catholic church and the classic Argentine Catholicism seeking to enlarge and consolidate his power. But the scale of present violence in Argentina suggests he may have unleashed forces this time that he may find hard to control.

When an ambitious man is driving for the top, he invites the support of many groups, particularly well organized groups which can channel their energies in his behalf.

But he has moved. He has effectively enfeebled the labor party, once his political ally. He smashed the labor union, a shop steward, frequent free press outlets. And then he tackled the Catholic church.

Church and state are indeed separate in countries like our own. But we have a constitution which safeguards liberty of worship and other individual privileges. Peron would offer none to the Catholic church.

Anyone who remembers the church's resistance to Hitler in Germany knows what trouble it can make for a tyrant.

But Peron was assaulting the religious faith of the great majority of Argentines. The resistance that those of us who live in a difficult terrain. He had no assurance the people would back him in this attack.

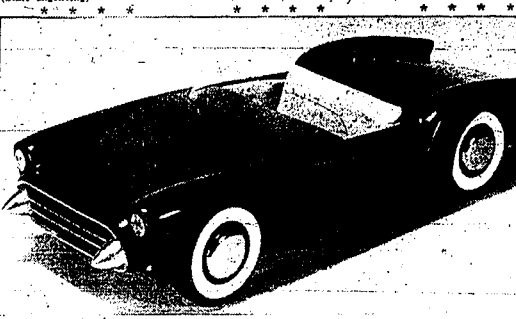

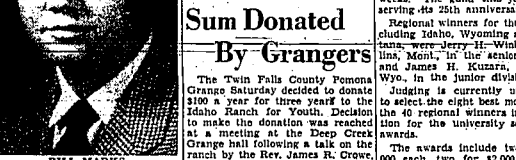

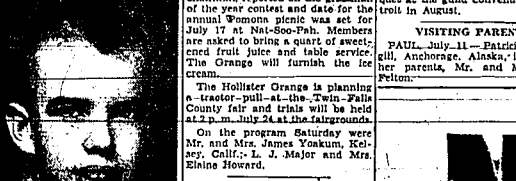
