"This was not the work of some mischievous youngster," Gillette declared. "This was done deliberately and maliciously by someone with a sadistic mind."

The police chief noted that the tree was cut off close to the ground by someone using a fine-toothed saw. He points out that marks on the stump indicate binding of the saw and says it must have been "real work for whoever sawed down the tree."

After sawing almost completely through the tree trunk, the tree was pulled back into an upright position. The vandalism was not discovered until wind blew the tree over onto a fence.

Dr. Oldham has posted a \$25 reward for apprehension of the person who sawed down the tree. Chief Gillette appealed to anyone having any knowledge of the act to report it to him immediately. He said names of people helping police solve the case could remain confidential if they so desired.

"Nearly everyone objects to acts of this sort," Chief Gillette said. "This is the work of a cowardly person. It was a deliberate, premeditated, malicious act."

No motive could be established.
