



#### H FOR HOPE

Almost from the moment the first-A-bomb was exploded over Japan in 1945, scientists spoke of nuclear energy's vast possibilities for peaceful use. But until now no one has spoken of harnessing the fury of the H-bomb.

That prediction was made at the U.N. atoms for peace conference in Geneva, and with it the eyes of mankind could lift still higher as they contemplated the future. Within 20 years, it is said, the hydrogen bomb process may be tamed to provide a new and potent source of fuel.

The forecast is stirring not only because it casts a great new light over a process which up to now has been linked solely with the most awesome destruction. It arcuses the hope of an almost inexhaustible source of center of the process. The form of the finding president of the process is the sole of the finding president of the process.

most awesome destruction. I continue to the conference, spoke of tuel as plentiful as the conference, spoke of tuel as plentiful as the "heavy hydrogen of the oceans." If men can indeed make the oceans the source of their future fuel supplies, one handling fear of modern civilization—exhaustion of its energy sources—may pass within a generation or two. But even without this prophecy, the news o' nuclear energy from Geneva is greatly heartening. For in addition to the U.N. conference, many nations are taking part in an industrial exhibition of a tomic power and other devices. And the word from this unprecedented show is that the peaceful use of this energy is advancing rapidly.

Atom power reactors, which can generate

Atom power reactors, which can generate electricity for judustrial and other peaceful purpases, already exist in America and the Soviet Union.

The United States plans upwards of a dozen more, but Britain is projecting no less than 25. Other European nations likewise have such reactors in the planning stage.

Britain's programming reflects a serious praspect of fuel exhaustion within the next few decades. Within that time the British expect to develop atomic power to the point where it will meet 40 per cent of the country power needs. Ultimately, it plans to satisfy at least 80 per cent of its requirements from nuclear sources.

clear sources.

Forecasts have it that by 1975 the steadily enlarging demand for energy will make fuel supplies an acute problem in most industrial lands. Conventional sources such as coal, oil

lands. Conventional sources such as coal, oil and hydroelectric power are seen as insufficient. This clearly is the atomic energy industry's great opportunity.

Again, all aside from the hopeful prediction of harnessing the H-bomb, the promise of the future is heightened by reports that an element called thorium, four to 10 times more plentiful than the uranium presently relied on for atomic fuel, may become the chief source of atomic power. Uranium's relative scarcity always has been a big stumbling block.
