Parties Probe Deep Mine for Lost Farmers

GEORGETOWN, Sept. 16 (AP)—Rescue parties held little hope today that two Kansas farmers lost in a cave abandoned mine have since yesterday would be found alive.

Clarence Dew, 33, and Melvin Lee, 45, both of Ulysses, Kan., went into the mine, dark 8,000-foot shaft about 2 p.m. Sept. 15, looking for uranium. They have not been seen since.

The two Kansans carried with them enough oxygen for four hours, and a collapsible boat which they were to use to get past a small lake at the 3,000-foot level. They had discovered the underground lake on an expedition into the mine earlier this week.

The rescue parties, equipped with floodlights, oxygen supplies and air compressors worked through the night attempting to reach the men. There was no indication the two were alive since the mine, a major contributor during the 1970s when Georgetown was a booming silver mining town, is filled with foul, poisonous air.

Leahy and Dew are believed to be lost somewhere past the 2,000-foot level of the mine. Whether the men had been trapped in the abandoned mine by a cave-in or whether they were overcome by fumes in the shaft.

J. C. Penney Tells Reason For Success

NEW YORK, Sept. 10—James Cash Penney celebrates his 80th birthday today, a healthy, buoyant executive of the chain of 1,653 stores that bear his name. If you ask him how he does it he'll tell you: "I've never a drinking man. I could say that drinking was the reason. But I've yet to taste my first cocktail so maybe that's the reason. I take vitamins every day, too. You can take your choice. The real reason I've stayed on the job so long is that I love my work and love people and I'm trying to do some good in the world. My only object isn't to see how many dollars I can pile up. If I have more money I'd give it away."

Penney, who opened the first J. C. Penney at Kemmerer, Wyo., 53 years ago and still refers to it fondly as his "mother store," planned to raise it his usual hour today, 6 a. m., and to be in the office by 9 a. m. on the top floor of the Penney building in the big department store district of Manhattan, where employees had cake ready for him.

He said the fact he was turning 80 was no reason to talk about retirement.

"I don't ever plan to retire unless I do. I never think about it," he said. "I'm not drawing a salary any more so they can't cut off my pay to get rid of me, either."

Penney puts in roughly six months of the year in New York as chairman of the board of J. C. Penney company. The rest of the time he spends at one of his 10 farms, where he has dozens of acres developing better strains of Angus and Hereford beef cattle and Guernsey dairy stock.

The son of a Baptist minister, Penney was born in 1876 at Hamilton, Mo., and got his first job clerking in a country store for \$2.27 a month. He was a poor salesman at first, and the proprietor offered to hire him more if he would run errands instead of trying to sell.

"I decided to stick to my ground and learn to be a salesman. That was the turning point of my life. If I hadn't made that decision I wouldn't be sitting here today."

Where he sits is at the top of a corporation that did more than one billion dollars worth of business last year, with sales running 9.5 per cent higher this year. The chain has 1,653 stores today, the newest having opened last week at Houston, Tex. Altogether, \$5 are scheduled to open in 1955.
