ings.

There seems to be a growing concern over tourist criticism of "over-rated fishing" in idaho, particularly in the Stanley basin control, and the Twin Falls Chamber, Mr. Holmes and others have been giving the matter serious consideration.

The new, hard-surfaced road over Galeia summit and plans for more oiling of U. S. 33 in the basin area next summer are presenting a real problem. Tourist, traffic has increased tremendously as a result of these improvements and the streams in Stanley basin are taking an unprecedented beating as a result.

Hindreds of tourists, particularly those from California, are flocking over the summit for "some of this flishing we have been hearing so much about." To say that they are disappointed is putting it middly, and the resort owners in that vicinity are predicting no little amount of bad reaction unless something is done to correct the situation.

Obviously, the time has arrived when a matter of policy must be established. If we're going to advertise for more tourist business, we'll have to live up to the claims in our advertising.

vertising.

If as Mr. Holmes points out, many local sportamen are opposed to any great tourist invasion into fatho, we had better weigh the extent of any such opinion and govern our devertising accordingly.

The point is, Idaho should be consistent because we are fast reaching a point where we'll have to make up our minds one way or another.

Certain business interesis are plumping for all the tourist traffic we can get to bring millions of new dollars into Idaho, but at the same time our legislatures, likely as not, will frown on any increased expenditures for fish hatcheries and the like to keep up with increased tourist pressure.

While some states are appropriating monies out of their general funds, in addition to all the revenues from the sale of this and game licenses, to keep their visiting tourists happy and relieve them of as much of their vascius spending money as possible, Idaho has quibbled over using all of its fish and game license money for such purposes.
