One of the great ironies of this age is pointed up sharply by even the cursory sort of look at Russia which the communists ailow visitors on their carefully guided tours. From its beginnings in the Revolution, the communist fatherland has boasted many things in the name of humanity. Their prize catch phrases have been plentiful, but none more overworked than "the classless society." This was to be the heaven of social perfection, where no inviduous distinctions were made among men, where all would be treated and rated equally. It was contrasted with the "shameful" class divisions of capitalist society.

The irony lies in what has really happened under Boviet communium. Far from creating a classies world, are more rigidly maintained as world, are more rigidly maintained that we capitalist class of the society that ever existed.

Russia has an elite class of top government and party leaders, military commanders, artists, writers and others which makes our upper social segments look like the under-privileged third of a nation.

These people can afford fancy country willas, big cars, privileged access to scarce commodities, veaction resorts, and in some instances have what amounts to "open" drawing accounts at the banks. The disparity between their living standards and those of ordinary Russians is suggesting using society grades down through secondary levels of the party and government bureaucracy, until at last the elerks, the factory workers and the common laborers are reached. Varying degrees of privilege acem to attach to each level. Lauren Both, editor of the Des Moines Register and Tribune's editorial page, observed on the American farm delegation's tour of Russias that wherever the group went the Russians bencountered were highly conscious of class and rank.

Further, Idoho' statutes expressly prohibit franchise taxes from being imposed as a source of revenue. They are intended solety for the purpose of paying the costs of administering regulatory procedure. If the franchise tax is too high, its legality might be questioned, on the grounds that it is more than enough to properly administer the regulatory procedure and thus become a source of revenue.

Statewide System

In Idoho Natural's single, statewide natural gas system, the savings resulting from greater purchasing power, single overhead and reduction in general expenses will make gas service available to all major Southern Idoho communities.

This integrated system will also permit serving all industries, including those located OUTSIDE the city limits. Anticipated revenues from industrial users of this type mean savings to consumers WITHIN the city of about 15%.

Separate, isolated municipal (or other purely local) operations not have this advantage. A municipal-type operation, for exple, could not serve industries outside the city limits.

Source of Revenue

Idoho Natural, like other business enterprises in your com-munity, will contribute its share loward the cost of government— state, local and Federal. It is expected that by the 5th year tax benefits to Twin Falls will exceed \$50,000 annually. As the system grows, additional revenue will be realized by the city.

The Municipal League Franchise

The model franchise submitted by the Idaho Municipal League, has been sent to all cities in the proposed INGCo area. Its provisions are a matter of public record and are known by all city councils and commissions in the area.

The Idaho Natural Gas Company accepts the proposal for a franchise tax of 3% of gross revenues for the first 10 years with an increase of 5% of gross revenues after that time, at the option of the city. It is also well to remember this: whoever serves you and whatever the tox (3%, 5%, 10%), it is you, the consumer, who will pay the tox along with your monthly gas bill.

If your City Commission wants a 10% franchise tax, that is all right with Idaho Natural Gas Company. However, in the interests of keeping natural gas competitive, it is considered advisable to hold the franchise tax to a lower percentage.

It is Idoho Natural's position that determining the franchise tax is the proper function of your City Commission. INGCo will be agreeable with whatever decision is reached.

Sales Promotion

The gas business is a highly COMPETITIVE business.

Utility companies depend on the sale of gas-using appliances equipment for increasing their sales volume of gas. This is ad load building . . increasing sales volume by selling people he use of gas service.

The success of the load-building program is the key to all util-ity operations. On it depends the anticipated revenues, investments in new services and equipment, and earnings. Projected earnings that are not based on this aggressive approach are not realistic. If the load-building program is not pressed aggressively, the entire operation has little chance for success,

INGCo does not contemplate going into the appliance business, instead, INGCo will assist existing appliance declers in promoting appliance sales. INGCo will do this with aggressive advertising and promotional programs that sell the idea of gas cookery, for example, with local appliance dealers tieing in their brandname promotions.

Because the gos business has become highly competitive, it is doubtful that anything short of an aggressive load-building program will produce the results necessary for the healthy growth and survival of the business.

Idoho Natural's rates, fixed as they are by the PUC to allow a rate of return of about 6% on Investment, will demond that load growth be rapid. Over and above this incentive is the natural incentive and tolent of private business to compete aggressively with other fuels and stay olive.

All of Idaho Natural's projected revenue is based on its firm conviction that it can and will develop the business to produce that revenue. In this conviction, it is supported by the best judgment of Stone & Webster and its own experienced operating personnel.

Industrial Development

The natural affinity of industry and natural gas for each other will make passible many new industries for Southern Idaho. The same aggressiveness required for building the local gas load will be necessary to compete with other parts of the U. S. in attracting new industry.
