





The battle lines for the Big Four foreign ministers' meeting at Geneva, Oct. 27, are now being drawn. In fact they are being fixed so firmly that a stalemate appears almost increase. Within the past few days the leaders of the West have decided to sive priority at Geneva to the issue of German unification.
