

DWORSHAK SEES RUSSIA
Those who heard Sen. Henry Dworshak's
talk at the "get-acquainter" banquet of educalors and businessmen at the Turf club
Thuccady evening, and had the opportunity to
visit with him afterwards, probably have even
greater doubts about our relationships with
Russia.

Russia.

In relating a number of his observations during a recent three-week trip-through West Germany and Russia, the senator made his listeners wonder-who's doing it to who' in this cold war battle of propaganda.

Senator Dworshak noted that one's Bonator Dwarshak noted that one's observa-ctions while standings on a busy corner in some metropolitan Russian city are not much different from what he would see in any American metropolis. Most of the Russian people appear well dressed, energetic and quite satisfied with their way of living. At the large airports in Russia he was sur-nisted to withess the same hustle and bustle characteristic of LaGuardin field—in New York.

nitsed to witness the same music and owner characteristic of Ladyardin field-tin-New-York.

The automobile and farm machinery industries also were impressive and quite in contrast to the story of "horse and buggy" methods we have been hearing about for years. While Russia's one hig automobile factory with 40,00 employes does not compare in size with our automotive industry, its production and efficiency are not to be minimized.

Russia does have pretentious buildings, immense industries, outstanding-fair—and exposition facilities, excellent horses and dairy cattle and modern farm machinery, he found. Her potato harvesting combines, in fact, were the largest he had ever seen. More significant than anything else, perhaps, was an atomic energy electric generating plant which the senator witnessed with this lown, eyes, Senator Kefauver, another member of the group who is quite familiar with our developments along these same lines at Oak Ridge. Tenn. had to admit Russia's atomic energy electric plant "seemed to be doing the job" even though "it might not be as elaborate as ours."

The question raised by all these observa-tions insturally makes us wonder why in our own country we have been led to believe Rus-sia is a land of wretched, under-privileged souls, ready to rebel at a moment's notice if

souls, ready to rebel at a moment's notice if they only had the opportunity.

Why so much emphasis on Russia's sup-posed incompetence? Has all this change come about since Russia turned on the 'new look'-and, gave us a peck under the Iron Curtain? That doesn't make sense, because so much could not be accomplished in so short a time.

time. What has been the underlying reason for all this misrepresentation, not by the Russian propagandists particularly, but more significantly by the publicity staffs of our own sometiments?

It seems to us that Senator Dworshak-is

It seems to use this feenator-Dworehak-it performing a real service in trying to clear up a lot of misunderstanding in this respect, because it's difficult at best for the American people to understand Russia and her objectives without the picture being distorted.

As one senator learned on the same triple CRussia, we even appear a little guilbie in some of our suppositions. When he intimated as if by challenge that it would be next to impossible to see what was going on behind the Ural mountains, he found the way was open for him to roam around in that area at will, probably somewhat to his chagrin.

We should be more realistic in all our relationships with Russia instead of playing Doegyman.
