



If Secretary of Agriculture Exra Taff Benson would come to Texas, take over the Boston place, run it under existing siding scale price aupports and show a profit. Boston would give his farm to Benson as a gitt.

A checkup by the Amarillo, Tex, Glob-Rows showed that Boston was no shiftless operator. He is recognized as the best farmer in his conservation district. Several years so he won a prize for raising 70 bushels of wheat to the acre in an area where 10 bushels is


