Senator Avers Ike Abandons Highway Plan

WASHINGTON, Dec. 27 (AP)—Senator Byrd, D. Va., has said the Eisenhower administration has abandoned its bond financing plan and will propose a pay-as-you-go interstate highway program at the next session of congress.

Byrd, who heads the senate finance committee, fought President Eisenhower's proposal earlier this year for issuance of bonds by an independent agency to help finance a \$3-billion dollar, 10-year road building program.

The Virginia senator said in an interview that the administration's decision to reverse its course represents something of a Christmas present to the taxpayers.

"I am very glad they have abandoned the bond financing plan," he said. "That will save the taxpayers \$1 billion dollars they would have had to pay in interest on the bonds."

Although Byrd would not disclose the source of his information on the administration's decision, Secretary of Commerce Weeks was reported to be drafting a new administration proposal.

TUCKER'S NATIONAL WHIRLIGIG

WASHINGTON—President Eisenhower's conservative or middle-of-the-road philosophy will dominate the next session of the Democrats, even if they hand their men in the White House. And it is almost a sure bet that their offering and possible winner will be the mild and modest Adlai Stevenson.

BY THE END OF THE year, or shortly thereafter, President Eisenhower will have named a majority of conservative Republicans, or to use his characterization, progressively moderate, to each of the important positions, transportation and finance.

HEALTH GOVERNMENT FACTOR—President Eisenhower's ability to change the philosophy, the trend and the direction of the federal government by his own action is not a new, but it is a curious and healthy factor in our political system. It makes it responsive to the popular mood, which even Stevenson is said to be.

GOP MODERATION—Candidate Stevenson, in view of his recent remarks on "moderation," might be entirely willing to carry on with Ike's ideas. In fact, the Democrats are worried that the GOP moderates or moderates, under the famous Humphreys decision by the supreme court in Coolidge's day, they will be the only ones for sale—massacre or extermination in the end.
