Burning Plane Misses House, Damages Auto

LEWISTOWN, N. Y., Dec. 22.—A fiercely burning jet fighter plane crashed in the yard of a densely populated housing area yesterday, just missing a small house containing seven people sleeping peacefully already buried out and no one was injured.

Capt. T. B. Buchner, 30, Grand Island, Neb., said he was flying over the Long Island community of Lewistown when he began having difficulty with the controls. He began descending and then noticed the plane, an FB5B Sabre jet, was on a collision course.

Buchner pushed the ejection button and was catapulted out into space along with the canopy and ejection seat. The plane crashed safely and he landed in a Lewistown back yard. The seat and canopy hit the porch of a two-story house.

The plane, by then a vivid ball of orange flames, crashed in the street in front of the house.

The craft bounced off an automobile belonging to Everett Weber, who was driving in an insurance policy to Mrs. Wilson, and landed on a bicycle belonging to Daniel Watson, Jr.

Buchner received only a bruised knee in his parachute landing. He is a veteran of 100 combat missions in Europe. He has been in the air force since 1944.

New Airliner Flies Atlantic In Six Hours

LONDON, Dec. 22.—British Comair's jet airliner blasted from Montreal to London in 6 hours and 48 minutes today in history's first non-stop Atlantic crossing by a jet transport plane.

The crew "makefasted" in Canada before leaving and lunched in Britain, as it completed the last leg of a round-the-world shakedown flight.

The jet flew at a cruising speed in a flying time of 65 hours and 43 minutes.

The average speed of 548

Dionne Quint Says Parents Not Ignored

NORTH BAY, Cal., Dec. 22.—The parents of the Dionne quintuplets said yesterday the four surviving girls ignore them at Christmas and didn't send so much as a greeting card.

But in Montreal, Yvonne, one of the four sisters, denied there is any family rift. She told a reporter the girls had sent Christmas greetings.

She said she is the only one of the four who has been home from the hospital since she came into almost \$250,000 on reaching 21 last May.

Yvonne was interviewed in the hospital nursing tent where she is in training. Her biggest emotional outburst came when a newspaperman tried to quote her father as saying the girls' attitude changed after receiving their money.

"I don't believe it, it's not true," she burst out, and ran crying into another room. Dionne had made no effort to hide his grief when he said:

"We didn't even write a card from them. They didn't write, they don't phone. They did nothing to tell us where or how they planned to spend Christmas."

Asked why she didn't telephone her parents, Yvonne explained: "We were on duty. It's not easy, this job."

Beulah, Yvonne's twin sister, is in training in the hospital. Marie and Annie recently underwent treatment and checkups in the same hospital and were discharged last Thursday.

An informant told newsmen that Marie and Annie now are living in an exclusive apartment house.

This was the first Christmas the quintuplets have spent away from home since they were born.

Peace Budget Is Adopted by Russ Council

MOSCOW, Dec. 22.—The national council of the approved soviet parliament today adopted peace budget program Monday at the opening meeting.

The budget for 1956 provides for \$5,450,000,000 in expenditures of \$59,241,200,000 rubles (\$41,208,000,000). This is the highest amount in the one asked for by the government.

'55 Form for Income Taxes Being Mailed

Federal income tax return forms for 1955 are in the mail for all taxpayers, says Calvin E. Wright, Boise, Idaho district director.

All taxpayers should read the instructions which fully explain the instructions which should be followed to prepare returns. Remember that records must back them, says Wright. "Please recheck before mailing, because faulty returns cost delays, penalties and interest charges," he adds. April 15 is the deadline except for farmers.

Feb. 15 is the final date for filing for farmers, including new social security self-employment tax, except farmers who file and pay estimated tax by Jan. 15 can complete their final return April 15. Also, Jan. 31 is the last date to file final social security tax on farmers' 1955 employees, said Wright.

Employers should be certain to have all W-2 forms from employers, before filing returns. Wright wants incomplete returns cannot be reached for correction adjustments until after the filing period, delaying any refunds which may be due, he explains.

Jan. 31 is the deadline for employers to issue W-2 forms to employees. If it is done sooner it will help employees file returns earlier. Wright notes Jan. 21 is also the deadline date for filing employers' tax returns for the last quarter for 1955.

For business and professional men and others whose income taxes are not all paid by withholdings from earnings, Jan. 15 is the last date for quarterly and paying final quarterly estimates for 1955. April 15 is the deadline for the first quarter of 1956 estimates and payment.

BOISE, Dec. 23 — A former banker and a former salesman filed motions yesterday they will ask the supreme court to cut down their prison sentences for immoral acts with minor boys in Boise.

Joe Moore, 54-year-old one-time bank vice president sentenced to seven years, was released from the Ada county jail after Chief Justice C. J. Taylor signed an order temporarily giving him liberty on \$500 bail.

Taylor scheduled a tentative hearing date of Jan. 9 for both men. They are among 15 Boise men who have been arrested in a morals drive involving adults and teenagers.

Meanwhile, District Judge Merlin Young gave James W. Sales, 31-year-old professional pianist, until Friday to obtain an attorney to defend him against a similar charge.

Justice of the Peace J. M. Lampert set Jan. 10 for a preliminary hearing for Gordon R. Larson, 31, a salesman who faces a similar charge.

Russian Soldier Flees to Norway

OSLO, Norway, Dec. 23 — A young Russian soldier braved sub-zero Christmas temperatures and made an Arctic circle flight to freedom, Norwegian sources disclosed today.

Name and rank of the Russian were not disclosed by police who took him into custody at Kirkenes in northern Norway, but informed sources said he was either an officer or a non-com.

The source said he was in civilian clothes when found by a police patrol and had spent two nights in the country in temperatures ranging around 22 degrees below zero.

Norwegian sources said the Russian has asked political asylum and will be held pending a decision by the justice ministry on whether to grant asylum.

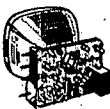
