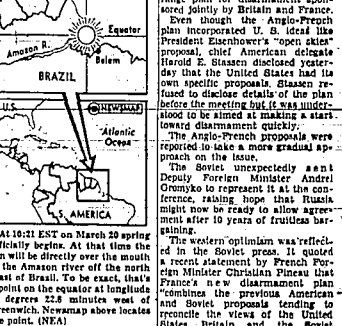

Last Bid Set For Votes in Crucial Area

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., March 18.—A Democratic primary makes a last bid for votes today on the heels of Sen. Estes Kefauver's stunning loss in the first head-on test of presidential primary.

Kefauver left the state on the eve of the election to vote on the senate farm bill in Washington. He said he was convinced that he had lost to Sen. Stevenson's edge.

Stevenson, Kefauver's rival in the Democratic primary, returns to Minnesota tonight in a last bid for votes. His supporters conceded that the Tennessee has gained ground but predicted Stevenson would still walk away with all of Minnesota's 16 delegate votes.

Democratic primary is the first head-on clash between the two candidates for the Democratic presidential nomination. Kefauver's family over a state of delegates favorable to Stevenson in last week's New Hampshire primary. Kefauver did not campaign in that state.

Kefauver has much to win in the Minnesota race and Stevenson has much to lose. The Tennessee, a Democratic underdog, could gain a major victory if he cuts deeply into Stevenson's margin.

Stevenson's margin is 10,000 votes in the state of the Minnesota campaign, but probably will be over Kefauver to "keep his bandwagon rolling" to high gear.

Work Is Coming

These committee meetings—20 or so every day—may foretell plenty of long house sessions later, probably in mid-August, when members are anxious to go home. Lazy Label Is Being Slated For Congress

WASHINGTON, March 19 (AP)—Some Republicans were beginning to grumble today that the Democratic-controlled 80th congress was doing much. One said it may go down as a "do nothing" congress.

Publicly, Democrats scoffed at the charges, which are aimed mainly at the house. They said much major legislation already has been passed, and that this is the reason members now can take it easy.

Privately, some Democrats were a little concerned. Let the "do nothing" label take hold.

Committee Active

It is a fact that little currently is being done in the house itself, although most committees, as always, are busy. While the senate has worked long hours daily on the farm bill, the house has been in session, sometimes briefly, only three or four times a week.

Weeks ago, the house scheduled an Easter vacation to start at the close of business Thursday, March 23, and still on Monday, April 9. Meanwhile, the calendar lists only appropriate bills and routine legislation to be considered before the vacation, and not much of either of them.

The lack of action on the floor does not mean members are idle. Delivered committee sessions, morning and afternoon, and tending to chores for the homefolks, not much time is left for house sessions anyway.

GAZA, Egypt, March 19 (AP)—An Egyptian military spokesman reported that Israeli troops fired across the true Gaza line in the Gaza area Saturday, killing a Palestinian Arab refugee.

The spokesman said the victim was struck by automatic rifle fire at the Moshava refugee camp near Dik el-Balich, southwest of Gaza; this district is under Egyptian control.

He said Egypt had complained to the U.N. moral armistice commission which has sent an observer to the scene to investigate the incident.

Campaign Slated On Contradiction

WASHINGTON, March 19 (AP)—Sen. Richard J. Neuberger, D, Ore., predicted yesterday that the "curiously contradictory" views of Interior Secretary Douglas McKay will be a major issue in the Oregon election this fall.

McKay will seek the GOP senatorial nomination in Oregon. If successful he will challenge Sen. Wayne Morse, D, Ore., in the November election.

Neuberger said McKay told Oregonians in 1954 the mounting cost of oil had prevented construction of the \$8 billion dollar Hells canyon dam. Now, he said, McKay is "endeavoring to secure final congressional enactment of the \$60 million dollar Hells canyon project."
