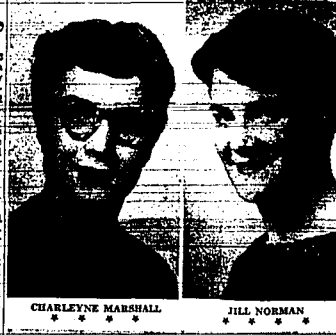

Newsman Will Be Allowed to Witness Tests

WASHINGTON, April 7.—Newsman and photographers for the first time will be allowed to witness and describe an H-bomb explosion this week.

Operating on a "pool" basis, 15 reporters and cameramen will be taken aboard a navy ship to observe a nuclear test that will be set off at Eniwetok proving ground in the Pacific about May 1.

The planned coverage will give reporters the opportunity for reporting on the events associated with a detonation and to see first-hand the operation of the many safety precautions which are taken in the public interest. The atomic energy commission and defense department said in a joint announcement.

Their statement said it had been decided that "uncensored public reporting with the exception of some photo-graphy" will be permitted without endangering the security of weapons information. Although news men have reported personally in Nevada, they have not been allowed to witness tests at Eniwetok since 1954. The test, than-announced, is an under-water, A-bomb blast.

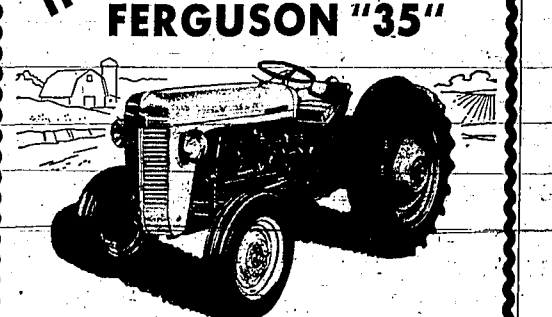

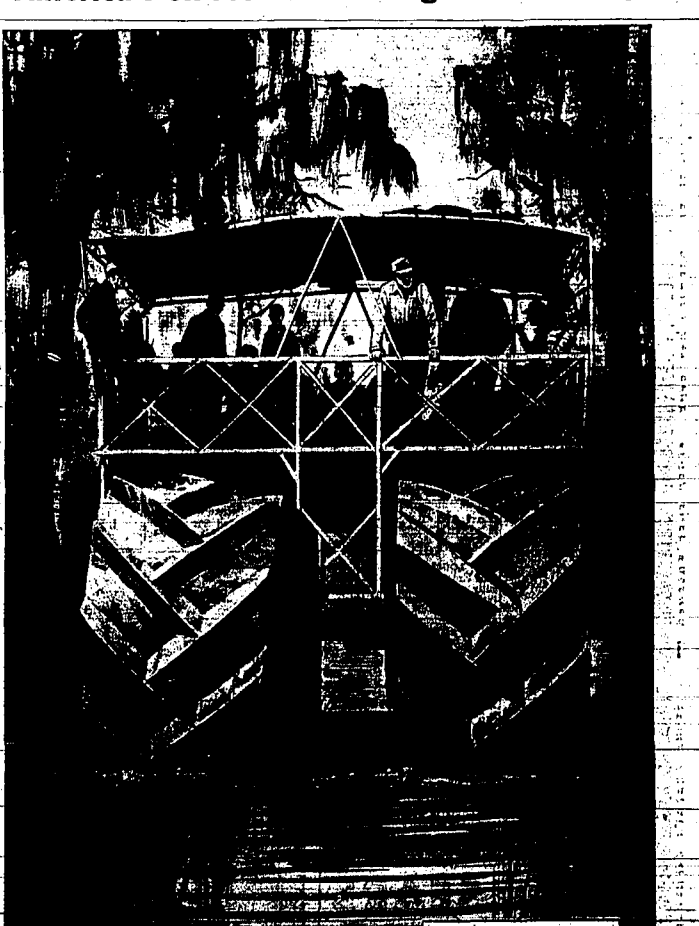

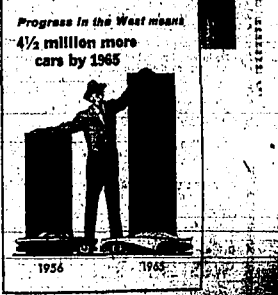

### Huge Runway Slated in State Testing Areas

WASHINGTON, April 2—The air force plans to build a giant runway, probably the nation's longest, for testing an atomic-powered reactor at the national reactor testing station near Idaho Falls, Ida., it was learned today.

The house has passed and sent to the senate an \$11.3 million dollar authorization to start the project. The sum is included in a two billion dollar military construction authorization.

Considered ideal  
Informed sources said the isolated Idaho Falls area, with its sparsely populated mountains and desert terrain, is considered ideal for testing the atomic plane. An accident conceivably might cause heavy radiation over the scene of a crash.

The air force, in conjunction with the navy, has been flying an atomic reactor in a B-36 over Texas to test problems of shielding and radiation. But the reactor has not been operated during take-offs or landings.

The air force in its request for \$11.3 million dollars said it plans an "experimental runway" with supporting facilities such as a taxiway, hangar, communications and navigation facilities, a fire station, an instrument building, a control tower, a decontamination facility and the necessary utilities.

Estimated cost  
Informed sources said the runway will be 15,000 feet or longer. It will be used not only for take-offs and landings, but for working on problems of taxiing the atomic-powered craft on the ground.

The atomic energy commission reportedly has been stepping up its work on atomic aircraft reactors. The AEC spent 22.5 million dollars on the project in 1944, will spend an estimated \$74.5 million dollars this year and plans 74.6 million dollars in the coming fiscal year.

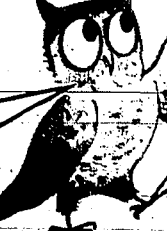
