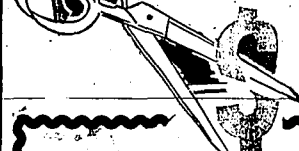

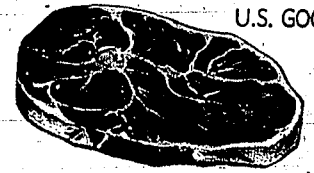

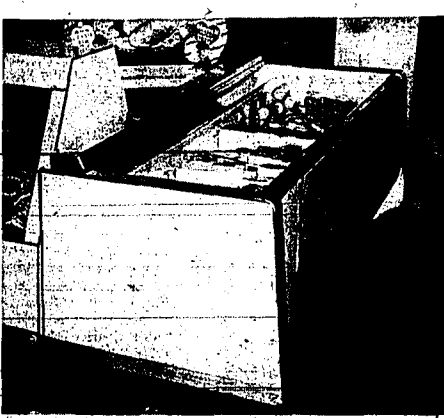

Stockpiles for Bridges Asked As 'Necessity'

PROVIDENCE, Ariz., April 11 (AP)—Stockpiling of portable utility bridges in potential disaster areas was recommended yesterday by the American Association of State Highway Officials.

The association, which has wide membership in 48 widely scattered areas with "hundreds of thousands of members, bringing home the need for some preparatory measures to cope with highway situations," Raymond Archibald, an engineer for the U. S. bureau of public roads, said.

"The New England bridges took the brunt of highway damage and destroyed over 100 Bailey military spans were shipped in and used to help restore highway communication."

"The Christmas floods in California and the Northwest covered an area which extends as far as 100 miles commencing for as much as two to four weeks."

"There were two times in one season when a stockpile of utility bridges would have paid off big," Archibald said.

The federal government should be responsible for any stockpiling program because there would be no difficulty in transferring the bridges across state lines during emergencies and they would be easily set up and made of interchangeable parts.

The Philippine government would not oppose a Japanese plan to join the eight nation alliance.

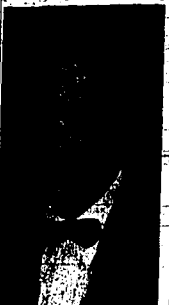

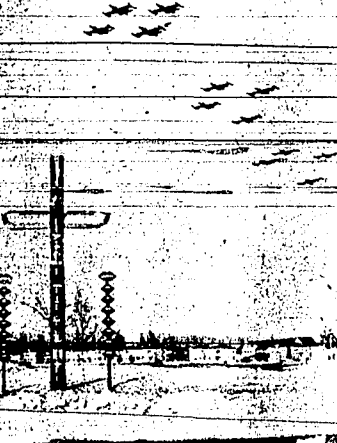

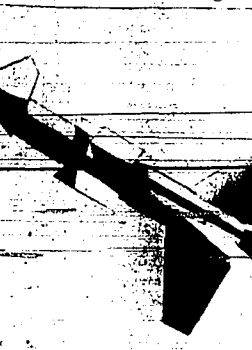
