Man Dies In Wreck At Rupert

RUPERT, Aug. 13—Magic Valley traffic death toll rose Saturday when Richard E. Seaman, 24, Rupert, died of injuries incurred when he was hurled from his auto onto a fence as the vehicle crossed the residential district. The accident, at 3:30 a.m., was the second for Minidoka county this year and the first for the county to occur more than for the corresponding period last year.

Rupert Police Officer Don Deane said the mishap occurred as Seaman drove his car "apparently at a high rate of speed" through a residential district in the McCool addition here. The 1950 Oldsmobile sedan failed to negotiate a curve on the road, plunging through a fence and into the front of a dwelling.

The driver overturned, hurling Mr. Seaman into the fence where a piece of the splintered wood punctured his chest.

Deane took the injured man to Rupert General hospital. He died at 8:20 p.m. Sunday.

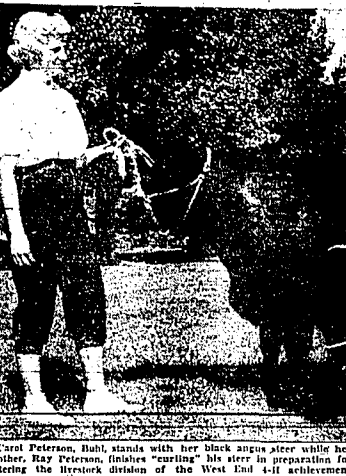

Truman Says He Will Back Party Choice

CHICAGO, Aug. 12 (AP)—Former President Truman said today he would be willing to campaign personally for Adlai E. Stevenson if the former Illinois governor wins the Democratic presidential nomination.

Mr. Truman, smiling down at a newspaper he was holding, said he hoped to walk with a lot of people a yard or so before going to the convention hall tonight to hear the keynote speech by Gov. Frank Clements of Tennessee.

But Good Time

The former president's chuckling over a whole of a good time is having a party's convention. He planned to spend most of the day conferring with a list of people a yard or so before going to the convention hall tonight to hear the keynote speech by Gov. Frank Clements of Tennessee.

Asked whether he intended to support Stevenson should he win the nomination, Mr. Truman said "I'll support the nominee of the convention."

"Does that mean you'll be willing to go out and whistle stop regardless of who he is?"

Wants Democrat

"Yes sir," Mr. Truman replied emphatically. "I want to elect a Democrat. We've had too many Republicans."

A reporter suggested that maybe Mr. Truman, himself, might end up as the Democratic choice.

"No, no," he said. "I've had my last race politically."

He shrugged off requests for comment from the former president's support of Stevenson and her stated belief that Mr. Truman is backing Stevenson and he is trying to split Stevenson and Hartman to throw the nomination to Stevenson's "favorite" opponent, Eisenhower's "favorite" opponent.

"She's entitled to say what she pleases," he said, adding that he had not read her statement.

Former T.F. Resident Claims Diligence, Sense of Humor Help to Learn Chinese

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13 (Special)—What does it take to learn the Chinese language? "Diligence and a sense of humor," says Ralph Powell, formerly of Twin Falls, Idaho, who will be en route to Taiwan (Formosa) this month as the U. S. information agency's country public affairs officer.

Powell should know. It took him 18 months of painstaking daily study at the University of California to master one dialect of a language which will come in handy in his present job: Promoting a better understanding of American among 17 million persons on the island of Formosa and combating communist propaganda infiltrating from the Communist Chinese mainland.

Powell, whose stepmother, Mrs. Milton Powell, lives at 321 1/2th avenue east, Twin Falls, is a graduate of Twin Falls high school and attended the University of Idaho, southern branch, from 1935 to 1938. He was born in Salt Lake City in 1917, and is the nephew of Mr. and Mrs. Harriet Powell of this city.

Powell says that an assignment to study the Chinese language and graduate of the University of California where he majored in modern European history, he enlisted in the U. S. marine corps and was wounded during the invasion of the Solomon Islands. S. embassy in Nanking, China.

Up until that time, he recalls, "I was more interested in Soviet and European history, but my knowledge of Chinese and my two years in Nanking led me to a study of Far Eastern affairs. I have specialized in this field ever since."

After his discharge from the marine corps in 1948, Powell became an assistant professor at Princeton university and at the same time obtained his Ph.D. degree from Harvard in 1952. He is the author of "Rise of Military Power in Modern China," a book published by the Princeton University Press. Before joining the U. S. information agency, he was an instructor and graduate of the University of California where he majored in modern European history, he enlisted in the U.
