Dam Hearings Reopened

With Testimony Given on Probable Financial Plans

WASHINGTON, Sept. 24 (AP)—A hearing testimony on financial plans for the four private utility companies to build two dams in the Snake river along the Idaho-Nevada border was reopened today.

A federal power commission hearing on an application for the Northwest Power Commission to build two dams in the Snake river along the Idaho-Nevada border was reopened today.

Spokane, Wash., PNP president, Ned Aeschel, testified, Gordon Brown, Portland, Ore., an attorney, will be presented by the PNP staff to testify on navigation and flood control.

UNITED NATIONS, N. Y., Sept. 24 (AP)—The United Nations special council meets Wednesday to take up the Suez canal crisis—the result of an Anglo-French request which emphasized their differences with the United States in the dispute. Secretary of State John Foster Dulles said in Washington he approved the French and British request to ask U.N. action. But both the British and French press emphasized the fact he wanted to wait until the Oct. 1 meeting of the Suez Canal Users association.
