POZNAN, Poland, Oct. 8 (UP)—A tense and rumor-filled day followed the sentencing today of three youths accused of killing a public security officer during the June 28 rioting. There have been widespread reports that new demonstrations may break out if the verdicts are harsh when they are announced. But tempering this were rumors that the government plans to halt the Poznan trials for good. Officials were believed worried about the reaction they have stirred up throughout the country.

Bud Wilkinson's Sooners, their merry way on Saturday rolling up a major college record of 32 straight victories, in the history of no one. Kansas State was the victim and the only question was the score. It was 66-0 in spite of, or maybe because of, the fact that Wilkinson used five full teams.

For the statistical mind, it was also Oklahoma's 34th consecutive game without a defeat against an opponent. The Sooners' record included a 10-0 straight game in which it had scored at least once.

If Oklahoma has a challenger for the top billing it assumed last year, it will probably come from among Michigan State or Ohio State in the Midwest, Georgia Tech, Tennessee, Mississippi, or unname Vanderbilt in the South, and one of several Southern conference biggies, including Texas Christian, Texas A and M and Baylor.

Southern California, probably the best in the Far West, can be expected to tumble in potential when Art Arnett and others of its half-dozen players, rattle after USC's fifth game. The Trojans, with Arnett gaining 12 yards, whipped Washington 13-0.

Michigan State, rated best in the Midwest West and No. 7 in The Associated Press poll, and Ohio State No. 6, used late rallies to defeat the Phillies.

The Spartans were outplayed by strong Michigan. The Sooners capitalized on a pass interception and a recovered fumble for a field goal and a touchdown and a 6-0 victory. Ohio State and Stanford had a scoring match for three quarters before the Buckeyes pulled away, 21-7.

Georgia Tech, ranked third by the nation's experts, was idle but Tennessee, Ole Miss and Army upheld the prestige of the South, Tennessee, moving back into the national picture under Bowen Wyatt, thrashed Duke 23-20 in the highest scoring game in a rivalry that dates back to 1892. Mississippi still in the poll, defeated Houston, 14-0.

Vanderbilt's power was unexpected and eye-popping in a 27-7 slugging of Alabama. Vandy, which used substitutes for half of the game, can be expected to turn up higher in the rankings this week. The Commodore here tied for 18-0 last week.

In the Southeast, TCU, the Texas A&M, Baylor and Rice (17-0), the Christian Baptist at Arkansas (14-0) displaying a host of pool leads as they are. Baylor, which has been given future member treatment, led to West Virginia 7-0.

Kefauver Hits 8-States Swing In GOP Areas

WASHINGTON, Oct. 8 (AP)—Sen. Estes Kefauver put his campaign caravans back on the road today for an eight-state swing which takes him to the heart of the traditional Republican belt.

The Democratic vice presidential nominee launched his third campaign trip—\$400,000 worth—either criticizing administration foreign policy and hammering away at President Eisenhower himself in a speech before a Zionist group here yesterday.

Kefauver, departing Washington in mid-afternoon, scheduled Dover and Wilmington, Del., as the first stops on his new campaign trip. Later he will visit New Jersey, New Hampshire, upstate New York, Iowa, Nebraska and Kentucky, winding up in Tennessee where he will take a brief breather to visit his family.

Kefauver, the second of his campaign about 5 a.m. yesterday when his chartered plane flew in from Tulsa, Okla. He was departed after three 18-hour campaign days, but "very much encouraged" by the result of his trip.

A total of 8,000 miles were logged during the trip. It brought Kefauver a total of 21,000 miles in 14 states.

In his speech here yesterday, Kefauver charged the Secretary of State John Foster Dulles helped bring on Egypt's seizure of the Suez Canal by offering the Egyptian to build the Aswan dam and then withdrawing the offer later.

Kefauver also attacked President Eisenhower's criticisms of Adlai E. Stevenson's proposals on ending hydrogen bomb tests and the draft.

Norma Sue Davis, 20, Miami, Okla., was selected alternate princess. Miss Lewis, 5-foot-6-inch tall, beauty who was third runner-up for the title of Miss U.S.A. this summer, won a \$1,000 cash scholarship, complete wardrobe and a gilded cow-bell.

Pay Boosted

CHICAGO, Oct. 8 (AP)—Some \$200 workers will receive a 13-cent wage boost over a three-year period in an agreement reached by two meat packing unions with Wilson and company.

The settlement—announced yesterday by the United Packinghouse Workers and the Amalgamated Meat Cutters—provided for a 10-cent increase retroactive to Sept. 24, a 14-cent boost next year and a similar pay boost the following year. Previous basic wage at the company's plants was \$1.68 an hour.

Winner Named

NEW YORK, Oct. 8 (AP)—A noted authority on atherosclerosis was named yesterday as winner of the 1956 Albert Lasker award of the American Heart association "for distinguished achievement in the field of cardiovascular research."

The winner is Dr. Louis N. Katz, Chicago, who was cited for outstanding contributions in research and education in the field of cardiovascular medicine. Katz has been director of cardiovascular research at Michael Reese hospital, Chicago, since 1950.

The volunteers are trying to persuade eligible voters to exercise their right—and their responsibility—to vote for the candidates of their choice.

The American Heritage Foundation, the major political parties and more than 100 youth, women's business, religious and veterans' organizations are participating in the massive campaign.

The volunteers are plugging city against city and county against county in voter registration contests.

They are providing baby-sitters for housewives who want to register, and hauling prospective voters to registration counters with car pools, chartered buses and even helicopters.

Except in states with registration deadlines already past, the emphasis today was on getting eligible voters signed up with the proper election officials, a survey showed.

Later the volunteer groups and their leaders are participating in the massive campaign.
