

Luxury Liner Fails Tests, Is Towed Home

BOULEVARD, Dec. 18 (AP)—The \$20-million luxury liner Statendam, newest pride of the Dutch merchant marine, was towed into port by tug yesterday after failing its trial runs.

The 158 million dollar Holland-American liner failed its trial runs in the North sea yesterday when two of its engines broke down in a near-gale. The towing job was \$48,000, Chesera Reised.

Hundreds of persons lined the breakwater and cheered the liner as it was towed into the port from the North sea where it had wallowed helplessly in the heavy seas. But it was a sad day for the sea-loving Dutch.

The spanking new liner ran into trouble just short of gale force, blowing in from the North sea, and three tugs dispatched to the rescue were forced to turn back.

Three Tugs Successful But the tug Titan, Cyclops and Zeland reached the sea, and with yells of black smoke pouring from their funnels began towing the big liner home.

The Statendam was scheduled to start its first regular voyage to New York Feb. 6. It set out Saturday on a trial run and on Sunday the captain refused to help in a private message to his headquarters. There was no 208.

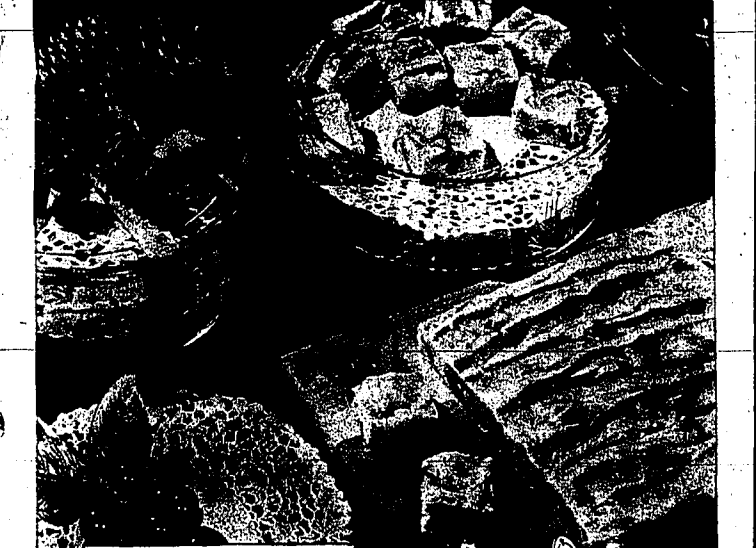

Union Leader Facing Battles For His Office

PITTSBURGH, Dec. 18 (AP)—A non-hold-barred struggle for control of the 100,000-member United Steelworkers union was being fought today in union halls and mills throughout the nation.

A rebel group of rank-and-file members has crystallized a protest against a \$2 a month increase in dues into a full-fledged drive against U.S.W. President David J. McDonald and his fellow international officers.

The "ins" have threatened expulsion for the rebel leaders. The insurgents make charges against the loyalists ranging from "misuse of funds" to "stomach cropper" tactics.

Nominations Tabulated
Three elected "kickers" from Nova Scotia, Pennsylvania and Ohio are tabulating "nominations" from the 2,700 locals of the U.S.W., the nation's second largest industrial union.

McDonald supporters readily admit that the rebel group will roll up the support of the necessary 40 locals to put its candidates' names on the ballot for next February's national vote.

The deadline for nominations was last Friday and the voters have eight more days in which to notify the candidates of their selection. But the campaign fire already has reached unprecedented proportions.

Issues Threat
McDonald struck by his threat to oust rebel leaders from the U.S.W. on the ground they were "promoting dual unionism," an arch crime in the American labor movement.

The rebel group's aims have blossomed widely from the original goal of forcing a special convention to rescind the action of the regular biennial meeting in Los Angeles which related dues to \$2 a month.

Don C. Harick, a U. S. Steel corporation worker from McKeesport, Pa., heads the insurgent group and is running for president against McDonald. In a speech last week, he claimed support of a million of the union's members.

Paul Hilbert, the rebel group's candidate for director of key districts in the Pittsburgh area, accused McDonald supporters of "misuse" of union funds in the election campaign.

He called for "impartial" observers at the ballot count next February. Hilbert was defeated for the district directorship in the last election by only 100 votes.

Actor Is Nabbed On Tippy Driving

HOLLYWOOD, Dec. 18 (AP)—Actor Anthony Steele, 28, husband of bus-actress Anita Ekberg, was nabbed early yesterday on suspicion of drunk driving. His wife spent more than an hour at the police station before arrangements could be made with a bail bondsman for his release.

West Los Angeles police said the 36-inch actress, plucked by the state trooper, "was driving a 1955 Buick called 'a horse blanket with silver.' Steele was arrested at 2:40 a.m. and his wife Ekberg appeared at police headquarters at 5 a.m.

Steele finally got out of jail at 8:40 a.m. after bail had been set at \$25. He was ordered to appear in court Monday afternoon.

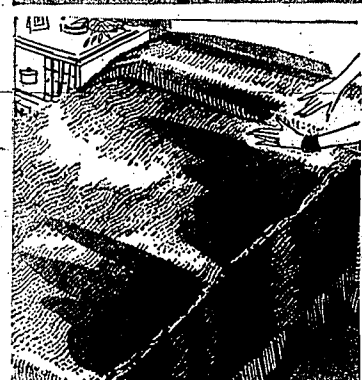

Nippon Fair Sets Tour of Asiatic Ports

TOKYO, Dec. 18 (AP)—A floating fair carrying samples of Japan's best mechanical products left Tokyo today for a port-to-port visit to eight nations of south-east Asia.

The displays mounted aboard the floating ship Nishio Maru demonstrated Japan's determination to win new markets for its rapidly expanding industrial output.

A large group of government officials and industrialists were at the dock to wave farewell to the passenger ship, which has been converted into a shipboard showroom.

The "Japan machinery floating fair" will make its first stop at Saigon, Indochina, Dec. 27. From there it will proceed to Bangkok, Siam; Colombo, Bombay, Karachi, Jakarta and Manila, with a stopover in Singapore for fuel and water.

All types of machinery are displayed, from tiny cameras and sewing machines to automobiles, mining equipment and giant industrial presses.

A spokesman said the floating fair will be sent to Latin America if it proves successful on its southern Asia cruise.

Private Utility Chiefs Outline Power Plans to Interior Head

WASHINGTON, Dec. 18 (AP)—Pacific Northwest private utility executives yesterday outlined for Secretary of the Interior Seaton their plans to provide additional power generation to meet growing customer demand.

Participating in the 75-minute meeting were heads of four power companies which organized the Pacific Northwest Power company (PNP) which is seeking government authority to construct dams at the Mountain Sheep and Pleasant Valley sites on the Jamn-Oregon reach of the Snake river.

Kinsey Robinson, president of Washington Water Power company, said plans for hydroelectric dams were not discussed in detail, nor was a special federal report on a prospective higher dam at the Pleasant Valley site. The report is awaiting Seaton's review.

Others participating in the meeting included Frank M. Warren, president of Portland General Electric company; J. E. 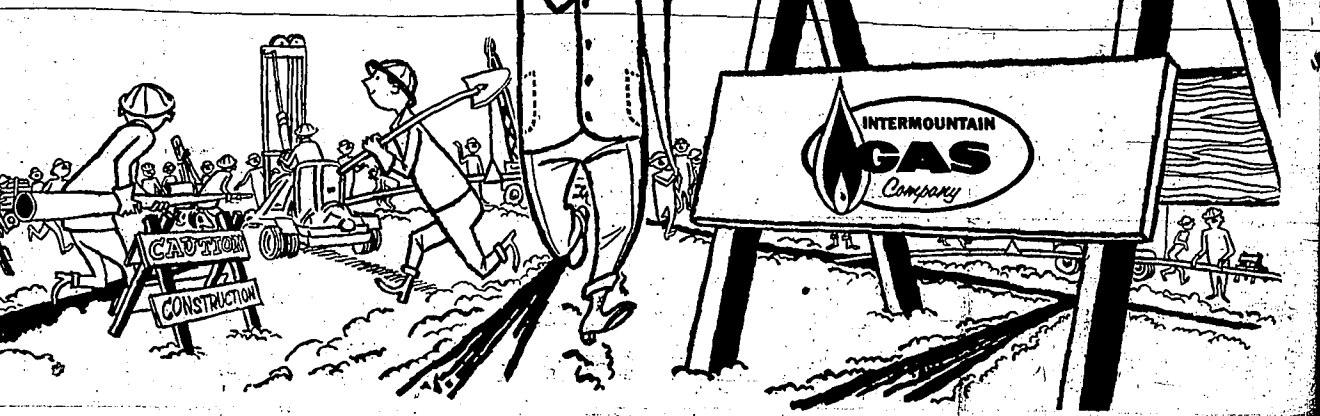

Poland Gets Concessions From Soviet

WARSAW, Poland, Dec. 18 (AP)— Poland won wide power last night in the use of Soviet troops in this country. A five-point agreement was signed with two top Soviet officials that makes Red army men and their families subject to Polish laws when they are away from military bases. The agreement means Russian troops will not be shifted around the country without prior approval of the Polish government. It also means the number of troops and their bases must be agreed upon and armed force cannot be used to exert political pressure on the Polish government.

The speed with which the agreement was concluded caused comment in Warsaw. Soviet Foreign Minister Dimitri Shepilov arrived to open talks only yesterday morning, less than a month after Wladyslaw Gomulka, Poland's pro-communist party boss, visited Moscow and came away with many concessions.

Among these concessions, the fruit of Poland's peaceful "October revolution" was the understanding that Soviet troops would stay to defend Poland's new territories along the East German border, but that their numbers and movements would be subject to a host of word from the Polish government.

Since then, Gomulka has proclaimed a policy of good neighborhood with the Soviet Union, but the high press has reported several instances of anti-Soviet demonstrations, particularly in sympathy with Hungarian rebels. It appeared the speedy dispatch of the high level Soviet negotiating might be connected with the disorders, and possibly also with an impending meeting of the central committee of the Soviet Communist party in Moscow.

Officials Battle on Report of Hospital

SACRAMENTO, Dec. 18 (AP)— Republican Gov. Goodwin J. Knight and Democratic Attorney General Ronald C. Brown have joined in an open political battle over the role of brutality in California's mental hospitals. Brown touched off the skirmish yesterday during a San Francisco conference when he, Knight, called it the "scandalous mental hospital situation" in the face of the state administration. The governor returned the blast with a charge that Brown was trying to "pass a political hand grenade" in a mental hospital report he had been completely discredited.

Forgery Suspect Waives Hearing

Edward W. Hathaway, 37, St. Arvo, Monday appeared before Judge J. O. Humphrey in Twin Falls and waived his right to a preliminary hearing on a charge of forgery. He was bound over to district court for trial.

A previous bond of \$1,000 was cancelled and he was remanded to the jail upon failure to post the bond.
