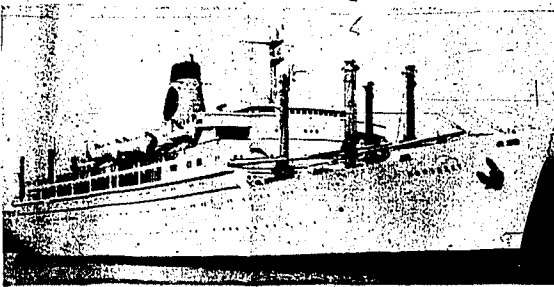

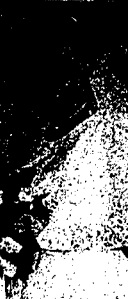

Care of Your Children

By ANGELO PATRI. I can only feel sad when someone who should know better calls the arts offered in the schools "course of study" or "trill." Arts are a necessity. Without vision, the people perishes and surely art is the expression of that vision, an expression of the aspirations of the soul. These aspirations are strong in childhood and youth, and they should be cultivated there. A child reaches for a pencil or crayon as naturally as he reaches for his best-loved toy. He grapples with his fist, makes a scribble with a wobbly line, and calls it a horse or a white-may-be. He is indicating his inherent love of creative work, and that is to be encouraged. To save the walls, it is well to give him a blackboard placed low enough on the wall for his short reach. As time goes on and he grows in stature and ability, an easel with a pad of manilla paper, large size, will make and keep him happy. Little children, those under six or so, should have large, fat pencils and crayons, a big fat soft piece of chalk for the blackboard. They are not ready as yet for the finer adjustments of the muscles in their inflexible hands that small pencils and penholders demand. That comes later. The idea is to take advantage of the children's readiness for creative work when it is apparent. An aid to art appreciation in children is the finely illustrated picture book. There are many of these on the market. Their cost is slight compared to what they can do toward setting an appreciation for good pictures in the children's minds and the stimulation they can give to potential talent. The creative worker needs an audience, so when a little child brings a teacher or parent a sheet of indistinguishable scribbles and says, "It is an elephant" or "It is a horse," the teacher or parent should not say, "What is that?" To the child his work is completely satisfying, and to him it looks like the thing he is intended. Praise him for the effort and refrain from criticism of any sort. School children from the first grade in elementary school to the seniors in secondary school need to have outlets for their creative talents. Because they will differ in their tastes and skills, the arts and crafts course must offer many sorts of work. Painting, modeling, weaving, cooking, whittling of many kinds, work with metals and wood—all these offer opportunities for creative work. The school should stress these opportunities as a relief from the tentative pupils of these schools and students. Usually excitement is caused by fear, about a classroom or a machine. The idea is to give the child a chance to express his own ideas. A boy and 10 girls in the city of New York, N. Y., in 1929, designed a picture book. There are many of these on the market.

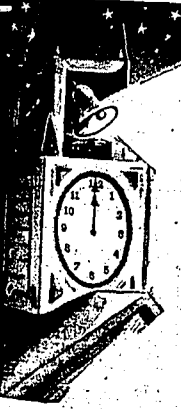
