

From our standpoint, however, it's any-thing but funny. We find ourselves in a ridiculous and embarrassing predicament that's downright serious.

that's downight serious. Despite this country's attempts to minimize the importance of man-made early astellites since Russia's revolutionary accomplishments in this field, it's a foregone contusion our national administration and minimizary authorities are both embarrassed and worried.

At long last, it also should be dawning on e people of this country that they have od reason to be concerned.

We admire our own Senator Dworshak for his recent outspoken criticism of our military departments. In a letter to Defense Secretary McEltoy, the senator criticized the "interservice tivalry" which he said existed in the defense department. He added that "glaring instances of duplication, waste and inefficiency" in the military services have been ignored in carrying out economy instructions from congress. Yet this time there is a difference. On those entiler occasions, we were trapped in dangerous circumstances because we had not been alert and had not been trying.

No one can say the same of our efforts since the cold war began.

We have been steadily aware of the peril for a solid decade. And, though we may not have started soon enough or always have done our best, the fact is we have been trying. Russia has not taken the missile lead

through our default.

That makes he present lag all the harder to digest. We are not accustomed to being bested at anything when we are putting out. But we shall have to accept the fact that what we have been doing has not been nearly sufficient, and that what the Russians have been doing is considerably more than we believed them capable.

This is a moment in history to test our faith in ourselves. We dare not fail into panicky fear, nor dare we cling to even the barest ahreds of our old compiacency.

In 1945 we exploded atomic bombs that literally put the whole world at our mercy. Russia, for all its vast armies, was in a deep dilemme.

But the Russians declined to be dismayed. But the Russians declined to be dismayed. They set about correcting a lag which was for them every bit as grave as that we now suffer. By every device of effort, legitimate and illegitimate, they closed a great part of the nuclear gap, and went on to surpass us in other fields.

us in other fields.

Can we in America show any less faith in our cause than this? Have not free men the spirit and the will to out-match men who live in bondage to ruthless tyranny?

That's the real test.
