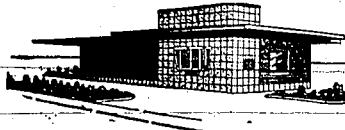

All available money was being used to develop this new country—to build roads, bridges, schools, etc. As a result of this condition there was some dissatisfaction among the few stockholders who owned the bank.

As president of the Fidelity National Bank of Twin Falls, I can look back to Aug. 16, 1911, when, as a young lawyer

from Chicago, I was fortunate enough to visit this new country and become interested in the small bank at Filer. I could not have found a more promising country anywhere with its prospects for future growth and productivity.
