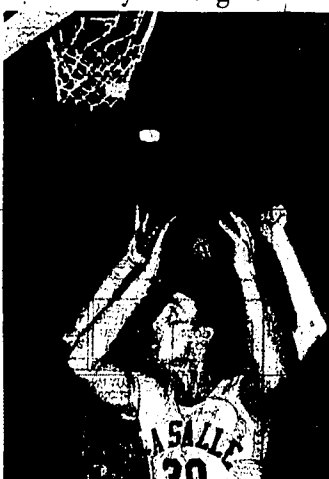

**Senator Asks 5-cent Boosts On Mail Rate**

WASHINGTON, Feb. 17.—Senate Republican Leader William V. Knowland proposes that out-of-town letter stamps be cut out of circulation three years and then cut back to four cents.

He offered this plan as a compromise to a bill proposed by Postmaster General E. A. Tamm to raise the out-of-town mail rate from three cents to four cents, and to raise the rate for letters mailed at other places than the home of origin from two cents to three cents.

The senate postoffice and civil service committee will conclude its report on the postal rate issue this week.

The house already has passed a bill to raise the first class rate from three cents to four cents, and a bill to raise the second class rate from two cents to three cents. It would also increase rates on other classes of mail.

The administration has asked that the rate for first class mail be cut at five cents, with one cent earmarked for modernizing post offices.

Knowland told nekeman yesterday he believed there was "no question" the senate would approve the cut-back plan. He said it was too early to predict what would happen to the five-cent proposal. He said it was too early to predict what would happen to the five-cent proposal.

He said the administration's postal program would meet postoffice needs and also provide stimulation during the current business downturn. As a matter of fact, he said, the program would be ahead in communities with heavy unemployment.

While the senate committee already has cut the rate on letters to be mailed to other than the home of origin, it is slated to bring debate tomorrow on legislation to raise the rate on postal and civil service employees by 7 1/2 percent, with program funds to cover the cost.

If the committee fails to act on the rate bill, it is expected the postal floor program will be amended to the postal salary bill.

### Mining Towns Are Hit Hard By Snowslides

SILVERTON, Colo., Feb. 17 (AP)—Snowslides threatened Silverton and nearby southwestern Colorado towns today with economic disaster.

Most of the town's entire working force has been cut off from the lead and zinc mines by an unusual number of avalanches in the area. Silverton's economy, outside of summer tourist trade, is based almost entirely on mining.

Silverton is a town of about 1,000 persons. Several other towns in the area are being affected similarly.

The "Hermite slide" north of Silverton broke loose Saturday near the community of Howardsville and the Pride of the West mine, taking out the only bridge between the mine and others in the area. The avalanche thus practically isolated the Cunningham Gulch mine area from here.

Jimmy Daudino, Silverton, in charge of the San Juan county sheriff, said an attempt would be made today to make a snow bridge across the river so that some traffic could be routed.

The highway over Red mountain, between here and Ouray and Grand and Treasury tunnels, has been closed because of slides, preventing Silverton miners from getting jobs here. Silverton residents are viewing the situation with great concern.

The elements seem to be battling against the hard-working state and county highway crews fighting to get traffic moving again. They no sooner get one or two slides cleared when more break loose. Slides have been falling on this high country for the past two weeks, and the snowfall hasn't let up yet.

More than 200 inches of snow has fallen in the area this winter. It was clear in Silverton yesterday, but more snow was expected.

The Hermite slide that broke loose Saturday was more than 1,000 feet long.

Last week, two avalanches buried four farms near Ouray, a mining community 23 miles north of here. Their bodies have not been found.

### Precedent Indicates U. S. Job Picture Set for Improvement

NEW YORK, Feb. 17 (AP)—The last time the nation had 4 1/2 million unemployed, eight years ago, the pickup in jobs began in March, the month President Eisenhower has predicted will see an upswing this time.

Historically, jobs are always fewer in winter but pick up in the spring. What has some economists worried, however, is the million-job drop between December and January, double the "normal" number and the biggest recorded since the 1930s depression. Quite a few do not share Eisenhower's optimism and think economic recovery will lag until the summer or fall. The nation's usual employment pattern has had some odd shifts.

In 1949, the pickup didn't come until April, but then the traditional pattern reversed and unemployment rose in the following months, reaching a peak for the year in July of four million out of work. In 1954, February and March were both bad with 3,700,000 out, but blazes to better in April and continued to improve with a few wobbles through

This February may set a record, however, as the worst unemployment month in 18 years. Secretary of Commerce Weeks predicts five million may be without jobs. The figure tops February 1950, when 4,700,000 were out.

The 4 1/2 million unemployed figure over which President Eisenhower expressed concern this week is actually for the Dec. 16-Jan. 15 period, cleared as January by the statisticians.

If this February's unemployment does not exceed Weeks' five million estimate, February 1959 will still hold the record for having the greatest percentage of the nation's working force without paychecks since 1941.

There's a lot of argument about that percentage.

The number of unemployed divided by the number in the working force gives the percentage of unemployed. Commerce department statisticians take this unemployment rate and adjust it for seasonal variations, part-time workers and a number of other factors.

The commerce department figures the January unemployment rate at 3.8 per cent. Administration critics, using different adjustments, say it is closer to 9 per cent. The unadjusted rate is 4 1/2 million divided by a labor force of 67 million is over 6 1/2 per cent.

The formula for comparing the modern adjusted rate with the unadjusted rate of 20 years ago is a statistical nightmare.

The government gave up and lists both in the economic report. Eisenhower sent congress last month.

Sometimes the adjusted rate shows a higher percentage over months than the unadjusted rate, and sometimes the reverse.

### Deputy Fired by German Leader

BERLIN, Feb. 17 (AP)—Stalinist boss Walter Ulbricht of communist East Germany fired Fred Oelsner as deputy premier Saturday. Oelsner was one of the so-called liberals kicked out of party jobs last week.

A curt announcement by the official East German news agency ADN said: "Professor Oelsner has been relieved from his function as deputy premier. He will undertake an assignment in the science field."

Oelsner, the party's chief ideologist, was ousted last week by Ulbricht from the politburo together with Karl Schilder, the 80-year administrator of the state's two security chief Ernst Wollweber was expelled from the central committee.

The three men were charged with trying to introduce Gomułka style independence reforms during the Polish and Hungarian uprisings against Russian domination.

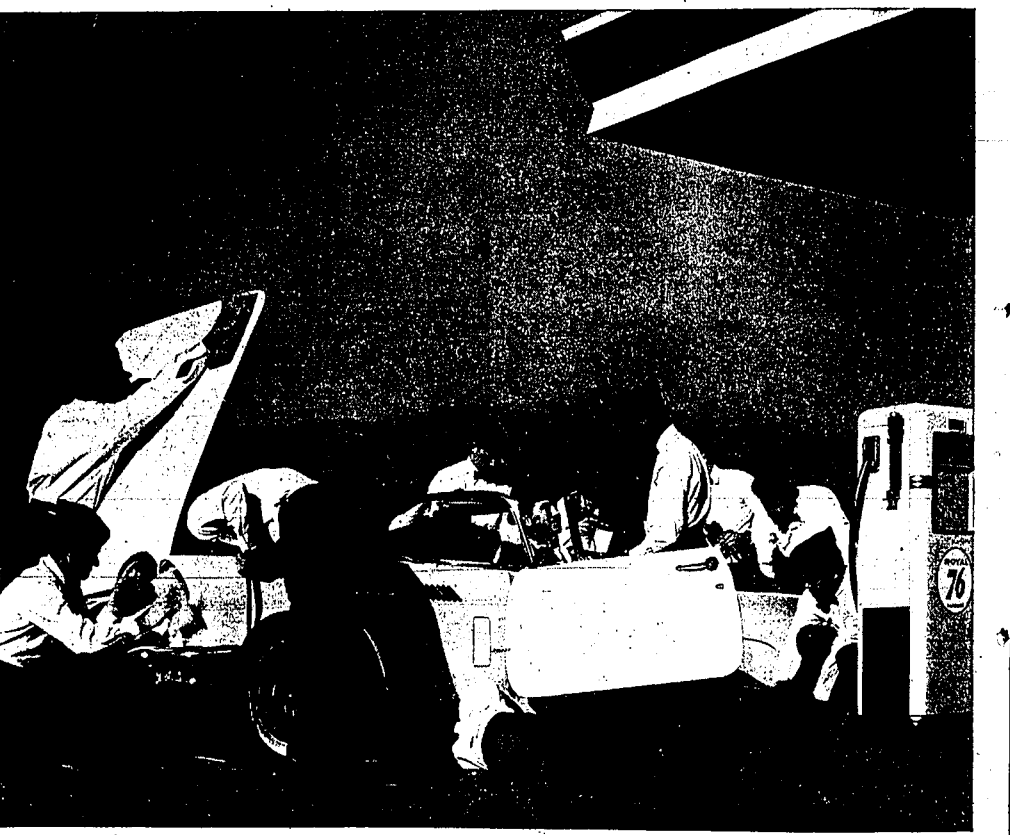
