Expert Citing Report Needs

Did you receive monthly social security benefits in 1957—over \$1,000 in 1957? Did you earn over \$1,000 in 1957? If you answer to both questions in "Yes," according to Lloyd C. Young, manager of the Twin Falls social security office, you must file a report of your 1957 earnings (with the social security administration) on or before April 15, 1958. This applies to those beneficiaries who were under the age of 71 throughout the month of January, 1958.

If you are receiving social security benefits monthly, you may earn up to \$1,200 a year without any loss of benefits. Young says, if your earnings exceed \$1,200, you will generally lose one fraction of benefit for each \$50 or fraction of \$50 by which your earnings exceed \$1,200.

If your annual report is not filed on or before April 15, 1958, you may lose additional benefits as a penalty. Young notes.

Regardless of how much you earn in the year, the Twin Falls manager says, you can't receive your check for any month unless you file a report more than \$40 in employment or other substantial services as a self-employed party.

WASHINGTON—Not since Herbert Hoover's darkest days have the responsible and accredited leaders of the Republican party leveled such attacks on their own party as they are now directing against D. Eisenhower.

"Never before," the Idaho senator emphasized, "have we in the United States faced an adversary with the size and the power of the Soviet Union. We had best, then, take stock of where we stand."

"An officer pointed to a small hook way up in the bomb bay of a large plane and he said: 'This is the only thermonuclear weapon that, if dropped, would be equal to all the bombs dropped by all the planes of all countries in the entire space of World War II. That is one single bomb!'"

No doubt Senator Church must have authentic information to back up all these statements, because it would be foolhardy for him to make such utterances otherwise.

For those Americans who still insist on being "Doubting Thomases," it might be well to ponder the following words of expression by five experts whose original confidential briefing papers were made public recently by the Committee for Economic Development.

"When I really feel gloomy I think that five years from now they (the Soviets) will be obviously superior to us in every area (military, economic, technical, scientific, etc.)"

"There is clear-cut evidence that the scientific, technical and engineering respects (in Russia) are given in the good high schools everything but the very best that schools here provide. In college the students are required to work twice as hard as we do and consequently are better trained."

"I am convinced that unless our Western society develops long-range scientific aspirations in addition to our short-range objectives of building and maintaining military strength, we will not be able to match the Russian accomplishments of the next decades."

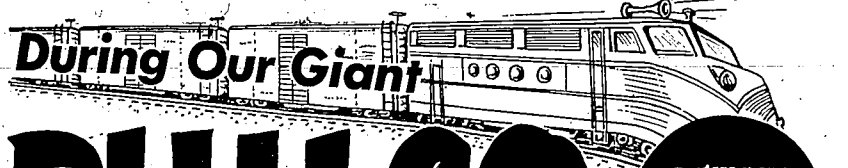
