Leave Hands Off Hungary, West Warned

STALINVAROS, Hungary, April 7 (AP)—Nikita Khrushchev warned the West Saturday to keep hands off Hungary. But he said he would be commiserate if they had better be commiserate to fight their own battles if they should be provoked.

Another revolt breaks out in Hungary, the Soviet premier said his government thought long and hard before it decided to send troops to Hungary to suppress it.

"You should not think if the country should be taken again, you should depend on the Russians to come to your aid," he declared. "You must be the savior."

Not Banaling Help

Apparently Khrushchev did not mean to imply he was imposing a ban on Soviet armed help, he said. It seemed he was warning that he was getting his own hands on to take care of himself. That he implied that the Soviet Union was in real trouble the father would be there to help, shaking his pocket, Khrushchev declared.

"We tell the enemies of socialism and communism that we do not care if you come in but if you touch us, you will regret it."

In Washington, authorities saw in Khrushchev's speech an opportunity to speed up a purge of non-communists from positions of political power or influence. They expected Khrushchev's visit to Hungary would be followed by a wave of arrests.

Though Khrushchev said he had no intention of making any speaking tour in the United States, he ended up by giving the Hungarian communists a message of support and encouragement on the knuckles. He spoke with great enthusiasm and with some hesitancy about putting down the 1956 revolt.

Faced With Decision

"We had to make a decision," he said. "We thought a long time about it. We thought about the fact that we had to stand by to watch the hanging of communists and the best way to do this was to let the Hungarians recently ordered many of their troops home from areas near the border with Hungary, but they were estimated that from 60,000 to 80,000 would remain.

"I advise you not to look just in front of your nose. Look beyond. Your clear consciousness should be stronger and you should see more clearly who is a friend and who is an enemy. You should be so sure of your enemies will always know that the Hungarian working class will not waver for a minute."

Russian Proposal "Same Old Story"

OTTAWA, Pa., April 7 (AP)—The White House said today that the Soviet proposal for ending nuclear tests is "the same old story."

An announcement by the White House correspondents covering President Eisenhower on his Easter week-end here said the new Russian text, delivered to the American embassy in Moscow Friday.

"It is nothing but a repetition of Soviet Foreign Minister Gromyko's announcement of the same proposal that has been discussed by telephone with the president and there will be no comment at this time."

TRIPOLI, Libya, April 7 (AP)—The bodies of two American and British servicemen killed in World War II collision of American and British bombers over the desert 15 years ago, the Ochs Oil company said yesterday.

It said sections of the bodies were buried in sand beside their plane, which crashed 10 miles apart in remote and dense country in the interior of Libya.

RAP sources said the British plane was carrying parachutists on a secret mission to Yugoslavia when it disappeared in September, 1943.

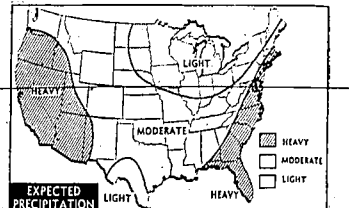
