The American people are more or less familiar with the Committee for Economic Development, an organization of 150 business executives and scholars working together to promote stable economic growth.

Duting the recent period of "unprecedented prosperity," when the American people were "living it up" or "living the full life," however one profers to describe it, they weren't paying much attention to the warmings and recommendations of the Committee for Economic Development. But now, with added inflation, growing unemployment and a recession staring them in the face, what the CEO has to say is commanding a lot more attention.

It was a rather startling announcement

was a rather startling announcement the CED made its recent anti-recession imendation for a 20 per cent across-the-reduction in individual income taxes

board reduction in individual income taxes if "economic activity continues to decline for two months below the February level." Any such recommendation sounds like good news to taxpayers, of course, but there was more to the committee's recommendations than just that.

Speaking before the Society of Business fagarine Editors at Washington last week, foward C. Petersen, chairman of the sub-committee on fiscal, monetary and debt annagement policy of the CED, made the ollowing significant observation:

"Twenty-six years ago, near the bottom or uwort depression, a Democratic congress and Republican president agreed to increase axes in an effort to reduce a prospective udget deficit. Today, in the early stages of a incomparably less serious recession, and acing a budget deficit in excess of 6 billion oliars, the whole nation is considering tax eduction to help arrest and reverse the economic decline. How the earth has turned in this brief span of years! This change is, thich the CED takes great satisfaction, for reflects the acceptance of many of the reflects the acceptance of the reflects the acceptance of the reflec

"In a real sense we cannot, under these conditions, afford permanent reduction," as the CED. "Given foresceable expenditure trends, a permanent reduction in the present revenue system would only substitute for some present taxes, bad as they are, a worse tax, namely, initiation.

"In the long run, we cannot 'give' ourselves tax reduction; we must earn it by restraining government expenditures and by increasing the nation's output. It would want to eliminate many provisions of the present tax laws which enable some people to pay much less tax than others with the same income. 


